The Department

From September 2024, all pupils will study either the three separate sciences, or Double Award Science at GCSE, and there will be healthy numbers studying Biology at A level. At GCSE and A level, the AQA specifications are followed, and results and value added are strong.

The sciences are housed in a very well equipped and beautifully appointed, dedicated Science Centre. The department is also close to the school's £2.3 million library, which is used extensively by pupils.

Biology has three laboratories serviced by the biology technician, working from a spacious modern prep room. There is also the wonderful advantage of an extensive estate with abundant practical outdoor learning opportunities.

All laboratories have interactive white boards with full wireless internet access for all pupils. All pupils have laptops and blended learning using various digital media is a strong feature of what we do. Culford uses iSAMS and the Google Suite of Applications, including Google Classroom, Google Meet, Google Drive and Google Sheets. Whilst experience in the use of these products would be advantageous, full training will be given as necessary to the successful candidate. The department has a generous budget and provides all necessary resources. Teachers wishing for specific resources are encouraged to apply for them to develop our educational offer further.

We offer a vibrant set of extra-curricular opportunities for pupils, including field trips, external speakers and a Medical Society. We are regularly involved in the Scholars' programme.

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Culford believes in professional and personal development and will seek to support the successful candidate in all areas.
