## WHAT WE ASK OF You

#### **TRAIN/EQUIP**

- Interview the candidate in the same way you would a traditional employee
- Give them a job description
- Allow them to shadow or to be trained in their specific position by you or someone at your place of business

### EXPERIENCE

- Perform job tasks for their specific internship
- Experience different roles within each level of the organization
- Gain experience in problem solving and critical thinking
- Observe and practice opportunities to collaborate in a professional setting

### MENTOR

- Model and teach business ethics and character traits for your field
- Show them "behind the scenes" of daily business
- Teach them what a career path looks like in this industry
- Train and prepare them in the way you would want an employee to come to you
- Help them become ready for a career outside of high school or college
