

STEVENSON HIGH SCHOOL MARCHING BAND ATTENDANCE POLICY

Marching Band Absence Reporting Form



Individual attendance at rehearsals and performances is an essential component to being part of the Stevenson High School Marching Band. When individual absences occur, the rehearsal experience and performance quality of the entire group is impacted. For those who use the Marching Band P.E. Waiver, frequent absences are also in conflict with the spirit of that policy, which requires an equivalent amount of physical activity through Marching Band as one would have through a semester of P.E.

Students who do not attend summer camps and/or consistently miss Fall rehearsals and football games are not upholding their commitment to the group, nor meeting the spirit of the PE Waiver. Therefore, students who meet the criteria below will lose the opportunity to participate in the Marching Band and will no longer be eligible for a PE Waiver.

CATEGORY 1: Students Who Attend Band Camp (Monday, 7/29 - Friday, 8/2)

- Excused Absences: Each student in this category will be allotted no more than **one** excused absence per season from post Band Camp rehearsals and performances.
- Unexcused Absences: Students in this category who have unexcused absences from **one or more** rehearsals/ performances during the post Band Camp season will be notified that they will be up for removal from the Marching Band (and the loss of their P.E. Waiver) upon their 2nd unexcused absence. Students will be removed and lose their P.E. Waiver if they miss any additional rehearsals or performances beyond the notification.

CATEGORY 2: Students Who Do Not Attend Band Camp

- *Attendance at Band Camp is strongly encouraged. It should only be missed in the case of unavoidable conflicts.*
- Any student who misses **all** of the rehearsals prior to the start of the school year (Monday, 7/29/24-Friday, 8/2/24) will be notified that they will be up for removal from the Marching Band (and the loss of their P.E. Waiver) if they miss **one additional** rehearsal or performance after Monday, 8/12/24 (first day of school). This applies to both excused and unexcused absences - neither are permitted for students in this category. Students will be removed and lose their P.E. Waiver if they miss any additional rehearsals or performances beyond the notification.

The steps will be:

1. Once a student crosses the threshold for absences, the band directors will meet with the student and notify them that continued issues with attendance could result in removal from the Marching Band and removal of their P.E. Waiver when applicable. Guardians and School Counselors will be notified.
2. If that student continues to miss events, the Band Directors will notify the Director of Fine Arts that the student has been removed from the Marching Band and the PE waiver should be eliminated.
3. If agreed upon, the Director of Fine Arts will notify the student's Counselor to remove the student's PE waiver immediately and enroll the student into a Physical Wellness course. They will also notify the student and their guardians of this change.

**In the case of Marching Band rehearsals and games, it is usually possible for students to participate in both their athletic games or practices and Marching Band on a given night. The Band Directors will work with families to adjust call times or departure times for students who have such conflicts.*
