Temperature of 100 or higher.	Vomiting within the last 12 hours.	Diarrhea within the last 12 hours.	Active, live head lice.	Redness and drainage or crusting from eye.	Rash with fever or behavioral change.

I AM READY TO GO BACK TO SCHOOL WHEN I AM...

Fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication i.e. Tylenol, Motrin	Free from vomiting for at least 2 solid meals.	Free from diarrhea for at least 12 hours.	Treated with appropriate head lice treatment at home and proof is provided to the nurse.	Evaluated by a medical provider and have a note to return to school.	Free from fever. Evaluated by a medical provider if needed.
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The above recommendations for when to stay home and when to return to school represent Pennsylvania Department of Health guidelines that the district is required to follow
