

# Liberty Connect!

Liberty Christian School provides students an accredited virtual offering designed for families who want to be connected to Liberty but need the option of at least some of their classes being online versus in person. Liberty Connect is an option for Kindergarten through 12th grade students with limited optional in-person social activities.

This virtual school option requires a semester-long commitment, including students is on a waiting list awaiting full-time, in-person learning due to that class being full. Monthly tuition billing begins June 1, and will be a 10-month payment plan.

**Liberty Connect will follow the Liberty Christian Academic Year Calendar.**

## A snapshot of offerings for Liberty Connect

### Kindergarten–5th Grade

- Class curriculum and instruction is delivered through Liberty University Online Academy (LUOA), an online learning solution provider.
- A Liberty faculty member will do monthly check-ins with the student, assist with any questions, and help with all registration of classes. A homeroom teacher will be provided for the following:
  - Chapel*
  - Liberty scheduled class parties*
- LUOA curriculum program provides the following:
  - Lessons that include combination of teacher-led videos, instructional online modules, hands-on learning activities, and independent study*
- Students will have access to on-campus chapels and will attend with the homeroom they have been assigned.
- The program will be most effective if supported by a parent, guardian, or another adult. This program is designed to be a partnership between Liberty and families.
- Students may participate in Liberty Youth Athletics (LYA) offerings.

## 6th–12th Grade

- Curriculum will be delivered through LUOA or online course providers currently used by Liberty for credit recovery courses and occasional online classes for Middle and Upper School students.
- Content will be taught by employees of LUOA or Sevenstar, and students will have a Liberty Advocate Teacher who monitors and supports progress, assisting with any issues with the online provider.
- The Liberty Advocate Teacher will do monthly check-ins via Zoom to make sure that there are no problems and to meet with the students about their progress in their classes.
- Students can participate in elective classes (based on availability) for an additional fee.
- LUOA and Sevenstar curriculum program provides the following:  
*Lessons that are both asynchronous (independent, self-paced) and synchronous (live, scheduled time) with a combination of teacher-led videos, instructional online modules, hands-on learning activities, and independent study*
- Students have access to Spiritual Life and Student Life experiences, like chapel, and are encouraged to stay connected and engaged by attending Liberty events.
- LUOA and Sevenstar have options for elective courses.
- Online classes through Liberty Connect are not included in GPA calculations for Liberty Christian for the school year.
- Students have access and support from the Guidance and College Counselors as needed.
- Liberty Connect does not directly align with our current class ranking requirements. If you have concerns, please contact the Director of Guidance and College Counseling.
- Classes will count toward College Prep with Honor requirements for graduation.
- Students will have the opportunity to participate in on-campus classes, if space allows, for an additional fee. Students will be required to attend classes and/or practices on campus for these activities in accordance with the Liberty attendance policy.
- Students cannot participate in athletics due to TAPPS rules, unless they meet the minimum number of on-campus classes.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Cost

Tuition for this limited enrollment program is outlined below. Students in K–5th grade may also choose to participate in LYA sports and pay any fees associated with participation in specials, if space allows.

Students in 6th–12th grade may participate in on-campus classes for an additional fee if space allows.

Grade	Tuition	Included with Tuition	On-campus Class Fees
K-5th	\$8,960	Chapel, LYA, homeroom events	\$3,000 for a class that meets 4-5 days per week
6th-12th	\$11,730	Chapel, Liberty support staff	\$3,000 per on campus class
9-12th	\$11,730	Chapel, Liberty support staff, National testing	\$3,000 per on campus class

### Is this a Christian curriculum, and is it taught by a Liberty teacher?

The K–5th grade curriculum is through LUOA, an accredited program that is taught by LUOA employees. It is taught with a biblical worldview. Foundation Worldview for Bible is video based and taught with a biblical worldview.

The 6–12th grade curriculum is through LUOA or Sevenstar. The teachers are Sevenstar employees. It is taught with a biblical worldview.

### Will students have access to Liberty Spiritual Life offerings and pastors?

Yes, students will be able to participate in chapel and discipleship opportunities. They also have access to campus pastors.

### May my child return to the classroom after spending a year on Liberty Connect?

Yes! Our goal is to have all of our students return to face-to-face learning, provided there are spots left in your child's grade.

### Can my 9-12th grade student take dual-enrollment classes?

Yes! Since they are still under the Liberty Christian umbrella, they are eligible to take dual-enrollment classes through the colleges that Liberty is partnered with to receive college credit and high school credit at the same time.

### Will Liberty provide a laptop or iPad?

At this time, Liberty will not provide, nor support, any technology to Liberty Connect students. Students must have access to a laptop or tablet to do their classwork. However, this is the responsibility of the family to provide.

### Is my child's principal at Liberty also my Liberty Connect principal?

Yes!
