His eyes, ablaze with wrath, reveal contempt and hate.

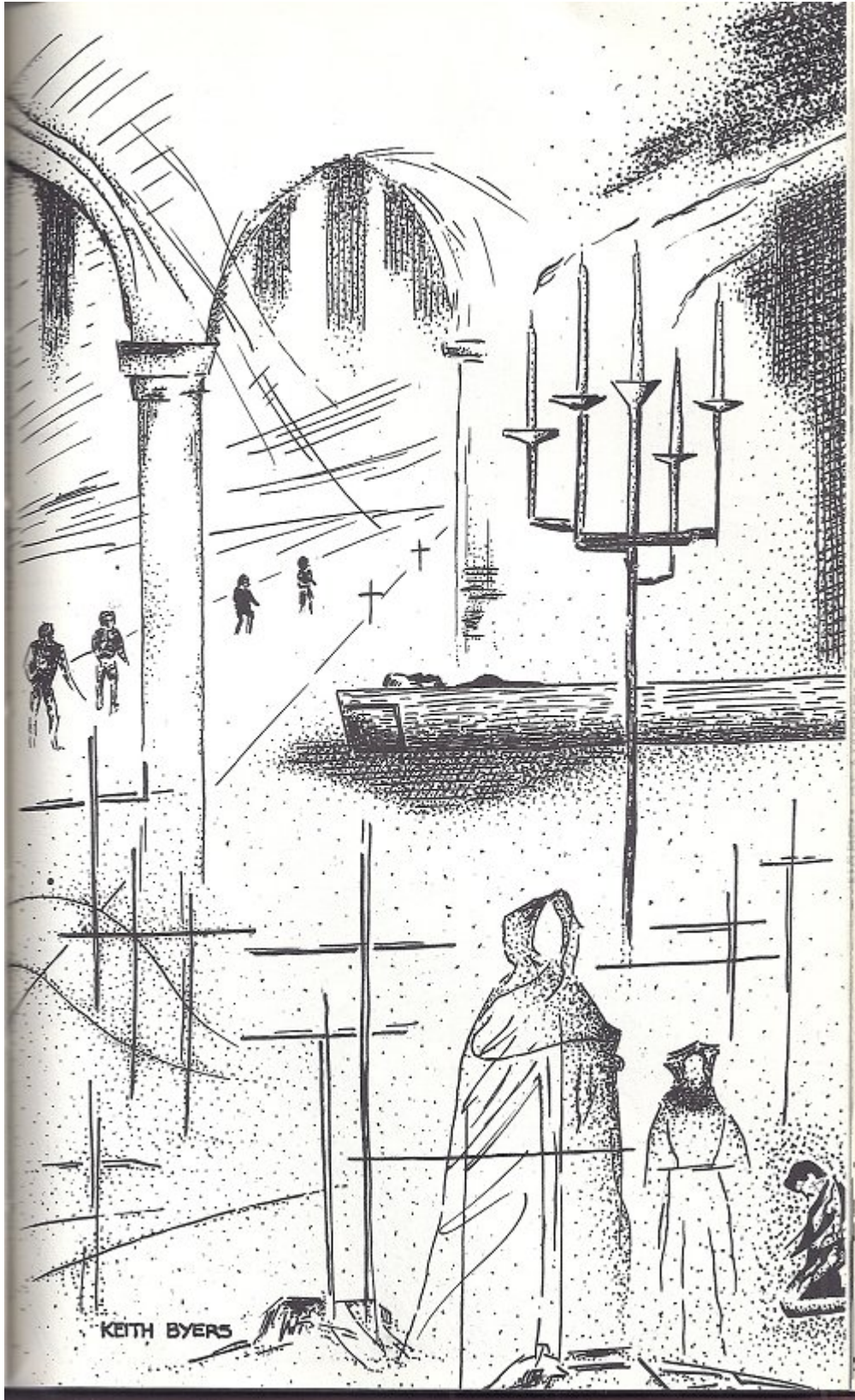
He paces! Screams! To free the fury from within!
