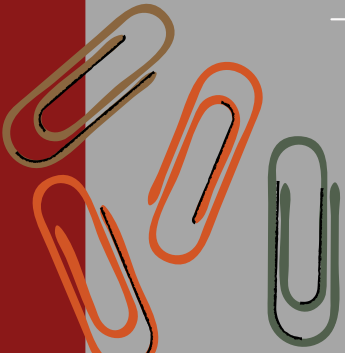
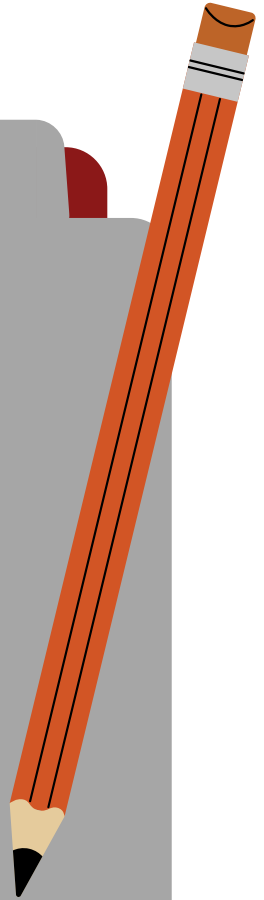

High School Credits

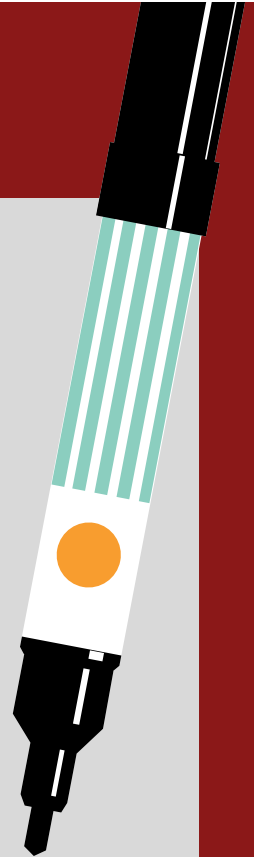


1	Students earn credits each semester (2 semesters in a school year)
2	Each semester is worth 30 credits / 5 credits per course completed with a passing grade (6 courses per semester)
3	Earn a minimum of 60 credits per school year
4	Failed core courses will have to be repeated until passed

You must pass all courses with a grade of D or better to earn credit

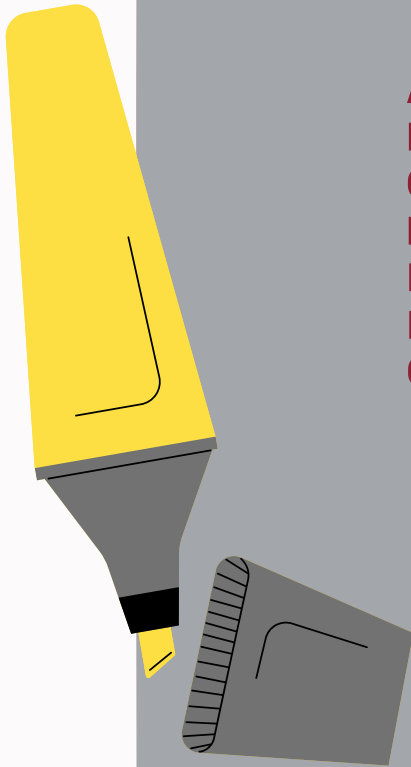
A-G Requirements

Courses that students must complete with a grade of C or better to be minimally eligible for admission to the University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU)



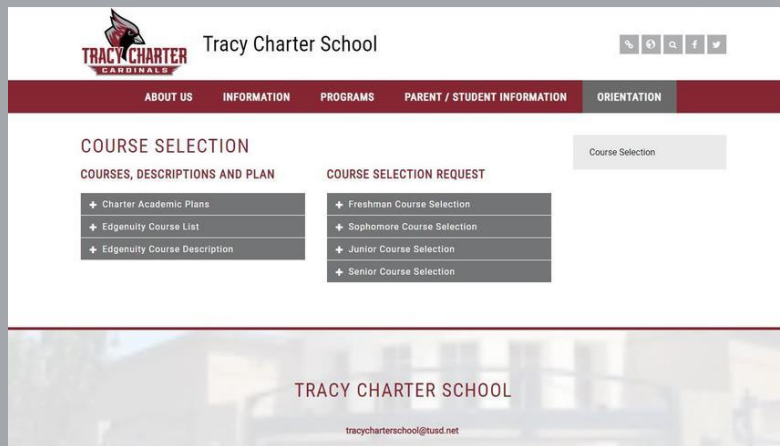
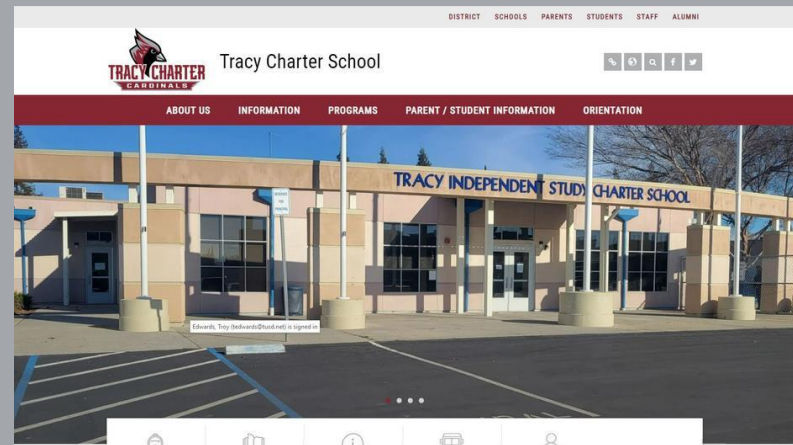
- A – HISTORY: 2 years
- B – English: 4 years
- C – Math: 3 years (4 years recommended)
- D – Lab Science: 2 years
- E – Foreign Language: 2 years
- F – Visual & Performing Arts: 1 year
- G – College Prep Elective: 1 year

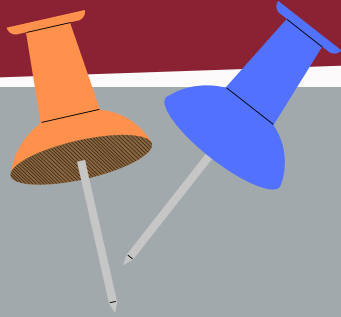
