



Digital Resources Permission Form

The Hillsboro School District utilizes G Suite for Education and many other digital resources for students, teachers and staff. As part of students having access to a District account, students are set up to use many digital curricular and collaborative online tools to achieve learning objectives and participate in school activities.

In order for your student to use G Suite, Khan Academy, and many other digital resources, parents or legal guardians must complete a permission form for each child attending an HSD school.

Technology use in the Hillsboro School District is governed by federal and state laws. The **Children's Online Privacy Act (COPPA)** applies to commercial companies and limits their ability to collect personal information from children. No personal student information is collected for commercial purposes from District approved applications. This permission form allows the District to act as an agent for parents in order to approve digital resources that your student can use in the context of school/educational matters. FERPA or the **Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act** protects the privacy of student educational records. Schools must protect against the disclosure of student educational records. The **Oregon Student Information Protection Act (OSIPA)** protects the privacy of student information by restricting what digital resource providers can do with the data and prohibits targeted advertising to students. The District reviews digital resources for compliance with FERPA and OSIPA prior to approving their use.

Conditions of access to HSD approved digital resources:

1. Students will be assigned an HSD account and email address when enrolled. These will be used to access most digital resources that are covered by this agreement.
2. Students will follow school and district policies for appropriate use as outlined in the Student Handbook and Student Code of Conduct when using HSD devices, network, accounts and digital resources.
3. Access to HSD accounts and digital resources is considered a privilege and the District maintains the right to withdraw access from these tools based on violation of laws, District rules or Board policies.
4. Parents are responsible for monitoring their student's use of applications outside of school. G Suite and the District does provide filtering in compliance with federal law and Board Policies on the District network and on HSD-provided Chromebooks. The District cannot control all internet sites and information that will be accessed or presented to students.
5. Users have no expectation of privacy when accessing the internet and digital resources through the District network or when using a District account or device. The District may monitor and access any information associated with this use.
