



BRIC the Driveway Frequently Asked Questions

Saint Francis High School recently kicked off "BRIC by Brick", the public phase of our \$100 million campaign. With \$20M to raise by 2025, every gift of any amount is appreciated!

In recognition of your contribution of \$1,000 or more to *Light the Way*, we are pleased to give you an opportunity to engrave a commemorative brick with an inscription of your choice.

How can I contribute to *Light the Way* and *BRIC by Brick*?

It's easy to give:

- o **Credit Card:** Give online at <https://www.sfhs.com/giving/light-the-way>. Please select "BRIC the Driveway".
- o **Pledge:** Pledge online at <https://www.sfhs.com/giving/light-the-way>. Once you select "BRIC the Driveway", select "Pledge to Give", and you will have the option to fulfill your pledge in up to 10 payments.
- o **Donor Advised Fund (DAF):** Please include "Light the Way BRIC by Brick" on the memo line.

There are many ways to give, which include donating securities, contributing from your IRA, and remembering Saint Francis in your estate planning.

What is the deadline for BRIC the Driveway?

Light the Way is slated to wrap up in 2025. When you give \$1,000+ by June 8, 2024, you will be given an opportunity to inscribe a brick installed in the summer of 2024.

Where will the bricks be installed?

The final stage of the comprehensive facilities plan will close the road between the quad, Kevin Makley Event Center, and the Graham Theater in the summer of 2024.

Under the loving gaze of the Holy Family, this new walking pathway will connect our Lancer students, educators and families with the brothers and sisters who have served and blessed us.

When will the bricks be installed?

If your pledge or gift of \$1,000+ is received by June 8, 2024, you will be given the opportunity to personalize a brick installed in August 2024.

If I give after June 8, 2024, will there be another opportunity to inscribe a brick?

If you give \$1,000+ after June 8, you will have the opportunity to personalize a brick included in our second installation in the Winter of 2024.

How many characters may I include in the brick inscription?

Each 4" x 8" brick allows for up to three lines of inscription. Each line can be up to 23 characters, including spaces, and will be centered.

What are some examples of brick inscriptions?

Some examples of brick inscriptions include:

- o Your family's last name ("The Smith Family")
- o Your family's last name, first names and graduation classes ("The Smith Family/Julie '75 & Paul '76/Jess '95 & Jill '81")
- o Your graduation class ("Class of 1987")
- o In Honor or Memory of a loved one ("In Honor of/Jane Peter Jones/Class of 1979")
