Los Angeles is a very large city and many of its points of interest are quite far away from each other, which means that some visitors consider renting a car for their convenience. GPS makes it easy to get around and find where you're going, but it's also important to pay attention to where you park and the price.

PARKING

Finding parking in Los Angeles is not difficult, but you should **pay careful attention to the signs in the parking areas**, which specify days of the week, parking on the left or the right, and other restrictions.

Car parks/Parking Lots may not always be the best option for short stays, as the rates for several hours are often the same as they are for 30 minutes.
