## Support & Education

### Adolescent Support Group

A forum for adolescents to discuss pressing issues and gain insight into themselves and others. This group focuses on:

- Personal/interpersonal relationships
- Social/interpersonal skills
- Communication skills
- Problem solving

## School Behavioral Health

Services are provided by a Licensed Clinical Social Worker or Clinical Psychologist at on-post schools. This program delivers behavioral health care in the child's school environment and improves service delivery and efficiency, by improving access to care and decreasing the burden on families to find services. Services may include:

- Psychosocial evaluations
- Psychological testing
- Individual/Family Therapies
- Behavioral Health Care Coordination
- Psychoeducational and Therapeutic Groups
- School/Classroom Observations
