WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

- Qualifying high school students can earn college credits by taking Cumberland courses while in high school
- Courses are offered in-person and are taught by a Cumberland professor
- Dual Enrollment courses also count as credits toward high school graduation requirements

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- To take dual enrollment courses with Cumberland University, students must:
 - Be a rising junior or senior
 - Have a minimum 3.0 unweighted high school GPA
 - Meet required ACT bench marks

LHS DUAL ENROLLMENT CLASS OPTIONS

- Fall classes
 - English Composition 101
 - Students must have a 20 on the English subtest of the ACT
 - Available to juniors and seniors
 - College Algebra
 - Students must have a 22 on the math subtest of ACT
 - Available to seniors

LHS DUAL ENROLLMENT CLASS OPTIONS

- Spring Classes
 - English Composition 102
 - Students must take Eng 101 or pass AP English exam
 - Available to seniors
 - General Psychology
 - No ACT requirement
 - Available to juniors and seniors

OTHER DUAL ENROLLMENT CLASS OPTIONS

- Some other courses may be available depending on your LHS schedule and availability in Cumberland courses
- Important to understand that any other dual enrollment class would follow Cumberland's academic calendar, NOT Wilson County Schools
 - fall break, spring break, snow days, etc

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

- Students have the potential to take 10 tuition free dual enrollment courses
 - Students must complete the TSAC Dual Enrollment Grant
- Other costs students and families may incur:
 - Textbooks
 - Any course or lab fees

HOW DO I APPLY?

- Step One:
 - Students should apply using the "Dual Enrollment" application on the Cumberland University website
 - Use fee waiver code FUTUREPHOENIX to waive the application fee
- Step Two:
 - Once an online application is submitted to CU, students need to complete the registration form and turn in to the Counseling Center to request specific courses
 - This is due by April 24th

HOW DO I APPLY?

- Step Three:
 - Complete the TSAC Dual Enrollment Grant
 - Please write down the username and password for the TSAC Student Portal as we will need it to apply for TN Promise in the fall

AFTER STUDENT IS ACCEPTED

- Required summer orientation at Cumberland
 - Student ID, parking pass, tie up loose ends
- Student responsible for checking email used on application for communication
- Start date differs from LHS
- LHS Guidance department will communicate with students and parents via Remind text group

AFTER STUDENT IS ACCEPTED

- Required orientation at Cumberland beginning of August
 - Student ID, parking pass, tie up loose ends
- Student responsible for checking email used on application for communication
- Start date differs from LHS
- LHS Guidance department will communicate with students and parents via Remind text group

DURING COURSES

- Classes scheduled during the LHS school day
- Students are taking college level courses and expected to keep up with grades, assignments and attendance
 - Take advantage of professor office hours, tutoring center, etc
- Class does count toward your LHS GPA

EARLY COLLEGE

- Graduate from high school with your associate's degree
- Available to rising Juniors
- Must have a 3.0 unweighted GPA
- Must have a 21 ACT Composite (22 subscore in math and 20 subscore in English)
- Cohort model - classes already picked for students in this program
 - Full time at Cumberland junior and senior year
- Cost is \$6,000 for entire program

DUAL ENROLLMENT EXTREME

- Full time Cumberland classes in senior year
- Work with Lebanon High School counselor to select 4 classes/semester
 - Can take 8 classes at CU during senior year
- Variety of entry level courses available
- Must make sure student still meets LHS graduation requirements
 - English, Math, Government, Economics, etc
- Will be on Cumberland's calendar, not Wilson County Schools

OTHER INFORMATION

- Dual Enrollment courses are weighted like AP level courses (5.0 GPA)
- Each college has their own policy regarding transfer dual enrollment credits
 - You do not have to plan to attend CU after graduation for these classes to count!
- Don't forget to use code FUTUREPHOENIX when applying to waive the application fee!
