

We look forward to meeting more of our 6th Grade families this Wednesday at Meet the Teacher Night from 5:30-7:00 pm, and in just two weeks, we will host all families for an Open House. If you have a 7th or 8th Grader, we will have lists, signs and staff members posted throughout the building on the First Day of School to help them find their way to their classes.

We will not be printing paper schedules for students. You or your student can access their schedule through Skyward Family Access or Skyward Student Access. We encourage you to have your student write down their schedule prior to coming to school on the first day, but in the event that you

cannot do that, we will be able to assist them when they arrive on campus.

Our staff has been working hard as we prepare to open our doors to nearly 1300 students in just a few days. Our district theme this year is Relate. Engage and Empower, and we cannot wait to do that with every student this year. Our new campus motto is "Learners Today, Leaders Tomorrow." At HMS we believe EVERYONE is a leader. To help our students grow as leaders, we will be implementing Leader in Me processes across the campus, and students will learn about The 7 Habits during advisory every Wednesday. We will also send out Leader in Me Family Newsletters so that you can continue the conversations at home with your students.

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With such a large student population, it is more important than ever for the school and families to communicate and stay connected. That starts with making sure we are consistent with student expectations. If you have not done so already, I encourage you to read through the Hutto ISD Code of Conduct with your student and make sure that they clearly understand the expectations for grades, dress and behavior.

At HISD and HMS, we believe that discipline is to teach and that every action has a consequence, whether it be positive or negative. In the event that a student violates the code of conduct, we will be implementing a Levels System in every classroom as a way to partner with our students and their families. We also have systems in place for rewarding positive behavior and celebrating students throughout the year. All students will earn Hippo Tickets in their classrooms and around the building when they are "caught" following expectations. Once the school year is underway, students will be able to use those tickets to "buy" items from our Hippo Store. Eventually we want students to run the store, but if you are interested in helping as a volunteer, please reach out and let me know! We will also have a Leader of the Week and Hippo of the Month, all of which will be celebrated with a breakfast at the end of each six weeks.

This week we will only have the students on campus for two days. In that time we will be getting to know them and going over campus expectations. Please be on the lookout for supply lists and other important information that will be sent home with your student this week.

Nurse's Corner

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Our school nurse is Mrs. Amy King! She wants to share some reminders about medications with our Hippo families:

- All medications must come through the health office.
- All medications including over the counter should be brought into the school by a parent. Paperwork will need to be completed for medication administration.
- Students are not allowed to carry medications on themselves, except self-carry inhalers that are appropriately authorized.

As a final reminder, please talk with your student about safe medication practices. Only take medication that was prescribed by a doctor, purchased at a pharmacy, and approved by parents or guardians.

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All Hutto ISD students will receive free brakfast in our cafeteria for the 2023-2024 school year.


Student lunch at the secondary level will cost \$3.
