

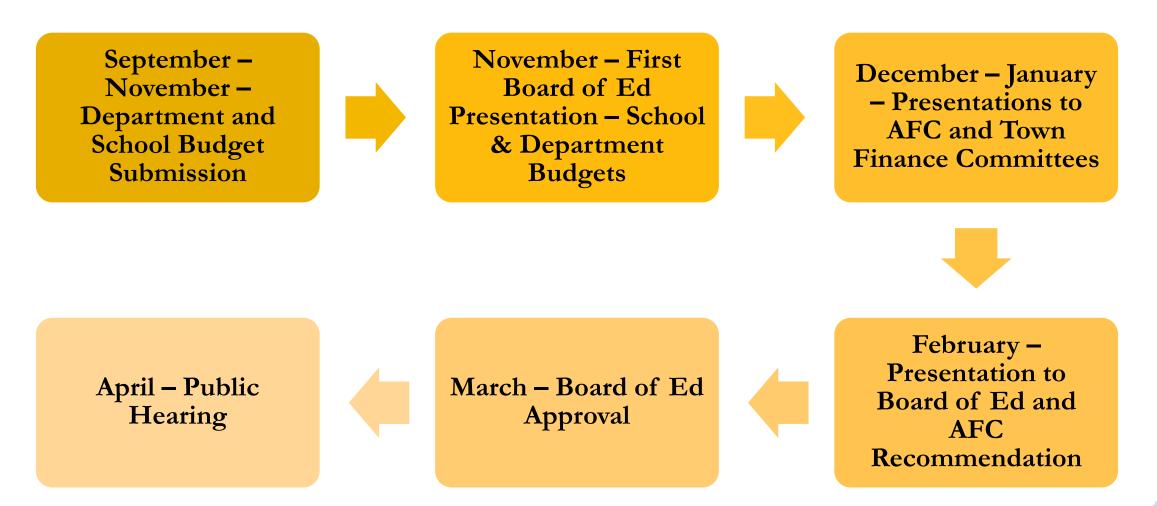

2024-2025 Budget Highlights

Support for Academics

- Maintain Exploratory, Teambased Middle Schools
- Maintain Comprehensive High School Program of Studies
- Adds new teacher for Financial Literacy Graduation Requirement (Class of 2027)
- Adds two new teachers for math intervention

2024-2025 Budget Highlights

Support for Extracurricular and Co-Curricular Learning

- Maintains Middle and High School Student Clubs and Organizations
- Adds Middle School Wrestling Program
- Adds Assistant Athletic Director



2024-2025 Budget Highlights

Support for Special Population Students

- Maintains English Language Learner Support
- Maintains Specialty Special Education Programs SAILS, Spartan Prep, Amity Transition Academy, Unified Sports & Arts
- Adds Transition Teacher to meet statutory requirements for postsecondary planning
- Supports Out-of-District tuition and transportation



2024-2025 Budget Highlights

Support for Student Mental Health

- Maintains Comprehensive School Counseling Support
- Maintains previously grant funded social workers and school psychologists
- Supports partially grant funded School Engagement Specialist





2024-2025 Budget Highlights

Support for Teachers and Staff

- Adjusts for Self-Insured Health Care Costs
- Maintains moderate medical reserve
- Includes new teachers' contract with 4.85% salary increase
- Funds new textbooks/renewal of online textbooks
- Supports statutory professional learning and curriculum writing and revision

2024-2025 Budget Highlights

Support for Technology and Facilities

- Maintains 1:1 Device Program for Students
- Funds specialty CTE lab at ARHS
- Supports instructional technology interactive white boards and teacher laptop replacements
- Provides for replacement classroom furniture
- Includes site improvements
- Identifies significant capital projects if unspent funds are available



Mitigating Budget Impact

- Funds medical reserve at moderate 18%
- Lowers actuarial recommendation for funding OPEB
- Identifies potential end-of-year purchases
- Delays some site improvements across 5-year period
- Reduction of support staff when new certified staff are added
- Reduction in transportation services
- No budget adjustment for in-process out-of-district placements
