

Weighted GPA

- Each term you'll earn a GPA for that term, and then at the bottom, it will show your Weighted Cumulative (combined) GPA.
- Your class rank is based on the Weighted Cumulative GPA.

There are two types of credit earned each trimester

- a. **Regular Core Classes** = 0.67, 0.67, 0.66 credit per term
 - i. Language Arts, Math, Spanish, Mandarin, Biology, Physical Science, AP Classes
- b. **One Term Classes** = 1 credit per term

The more credit a class is worth, bigger the impact on GPA

Oregon Seal of Biliteracy



Starting junior year, students who are fluent in two or more languages can apply for the Oregon Seal of Biliteracy. The Seal of Biliteracy is placed on your diploma and awarded to you at graduation.

Students attending SOU, WOU, or OSU can have their two-years of world language requirement waived for admission. Students who earn the Seal of Biliteracy can also earn high school CTA credit for their second language proficiency.

Oregon Seal of Biliteracy



Eligibility Requirements:

--Interested students must prove proficiency in reading, writing, speaking, and listening in two or more languages by completing a combination of testing and portfolio work. We can use scores from tests you have already taken such as the PreAct, ACT, PSAT, SAT, and Oregon State Testing (OSAS) Scores. There are additional options available as well.

--Must be on-track to graduate/meet school's graduation requirements.

College Now!

- ◆ Earn college credits for classes taught at Crater by Crater teachers.

Some are free and others come at a significantly reduced cost.

College Online

Sign up to take college classes through Klamath Community College or Rogue Community College while you are still in high school.

What's Offered?

- Advanced Placement Classes
- Core Classes: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Anatomy, & Pre-Calculus

- Finish your college prerequisite classes before graduating high school.

4-Year Colleges/Universities

- **C- or better on Core Classes** (math, social science, science, language arts)
- 2 years of the same world language (**C or better**)
 - Exception OIT (no world language) and EOU (1 yr world language in high school and 1 in college)
- 3 years of math (**Alg. 2 or above; C or better**) BUT prefer 4 years of math
 - Oregon Institute of Technology requires 4 years of math

2-Year Community Colleges

- Require a diploma or GED for admission.
- No world language requirement.
- Required to take a **placement test to determine your skill level in math, reading, and writing** (unless already earned college credits that meet the prerequisites like WR 121 or MTH 243).
 - If you score below the “college ready” level you must pay to take remediation classes that do not count toward any degree or certificate program.
- Earn a **1-year certificate**, a **2-year Associates of Arts degree**, or do a **transfer program** and transfer to a 4-year university after two years.
- CTE Programs like Diesel Mechanics, Welding, Fire Science, Allied Health, Electrical, Phlebotomy, Certified Nursing Assistant, etc.

Trade School Minimum Requirements to Apply

Union Electrician Apprenticeship

- 2.0 GPA minimum; at least through Algebra II with C or better grade;
- Score Platinum on placement tests in applied math, reading/writing workplace documents, and graphic literacy.
- School for one day a week for 8 hours for 4-5 years.
- Tuition is \$1,000 + \$400-\$800 for books per term.

Union Plumbers & Steamfitters Apprenticeship

- 2.0 GPA minimum; C or better in Algebra
- School is 2 nights a week, for 3 hours each night, which equates to 108 hours per term, and 216 hours per year.
- There is a Registration Fee of \$100 per term. There are also occasional mandatory classes on weekends. Books are sold at a 50% discount to Apprentices.

Reserve Officer Training Corps is a college program offered at more than 1,700 colleges and universities across the United States that prepares young adults to become officers in the U.S. Military.

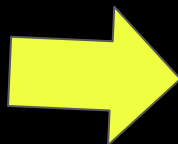

High School Athletics

- ❖ Must be **taking/passing 5 out of 6** classes the **term before/during** sport
- ❖ Must have **earned enough credits on the first day** **of the school year**
 - 10th graders must have at least 9 credits
 - 11th graders must have at least 20 credits
 - 12th graders must have at least 34 credits

Want to be a College Athlete?

- ❖ **NCAA** requires minimum **GPA 2.3 in core classes** (*you don't get to count any electives*) and **16 Year-Long Core Classes**
 - 4 years English (**minimum 8 credits**)
 - 3 years math (**minimum 6 credits**)
 - 3 years natural/physical science (**minimum 6 credits**)
 - 2 years social science (**minimum 4 credits**)
 - 4 years of either foreign language, math, science, social science, English (**minimum 8 credits--any combo of the courses are ok**)
- ❖ **NAIA** requires minimum **3.0 GPA** midway through senior year

What If Your Grades Were Not As Good As You'd Like?

- You have to go to class. Attendance matters!
- You have to learn how to study.
 - *Quizlet or note cards*
 - *Study groups*
 - *Meet with teachers during office hours or by appointment*
 - *Rogue Valley Tutoring Center*
 - *TRiO Tutoring App*
- You have to get involved in class activities & discussions
- **Making Up Credits**
 - Retake some classes (math & science) to fix the F
 - **\$85 charge for credit recovery** in Acellus
 - Summer School (there will be a charge for this).
