Mrs. Linda Klime presented information regarding the tile replacement at Lansingburgh High School. The District is requesting that the Board of Education approve the use of \$225,000 from the Repair Reserve to continue and hopefully finish the repair/replacement work of the LHS wall tiles. Last summer we were able to replace wall tiles on the 2nd floor that were deemed a safety hazard. The tiles were literally falling off the wall. As we now know that the workmanship on the entire job was poor, we are being proactive in replacing the remaining wall tile on the first and basement floors as well as in the stairwells before they become an issue. The estimated cost is based on the expenses incurred for the 2nd floor extrapolated out to finish the job. Once approved by the Board of Education, our Architects will release a bid to garner the best pricing. **PUBLIC HEARING**
