Meeting Called to Order at 5:07 p.m.

P. Beattie made a recommendation to hire Jacqueline Barresi-O'Connor as the Special Educator teacher for the Lamoille Union High School (LUHS), at a 1 FTE, M15 Step 14, annual salary amount of \$71,705.

P. Beattie shared that J. Scannell was invited to discuss J. Barresi-O'Connor's teaching experience.

J. Scannell began by sharing that Jacqueline has been with us before and returning from exploring another district. She is a veteran teacher who understands our community, culture, students, families and school. She will be filling a much-needed position.

Motion made by J. Hunsberger and Seconded by B. Bezio

T. Sweet asked if everyone was in favor of hiring J. Barresi-O'Connor. All present were in favor.

P. Beattie made a recommendation to hire Ryley Cota as the Family and Consumer Science teacher for the Lamoille Union High School (LUHS), at a 1 FTE, B Step 1, annual salary amount of \$46,205.

P. Beattie shared that B. Pirie was invited to discuss R. Cota's teaching experience.

Bethann shared that Ryley is a current employee who is interested in moving into the classroom. The position would allow Ryley the opportunity to teach life skills such as selfcare, community, and skills needed in order to navigate the many challenges of adult life.

Motion made by J. Hunsberger and Seconded by S. Sweet.

T. Sweet asked if everyone was in favor of hiring R. Cota. All present were in favor.

P. Beattie made a recommendation to hire Norah Connolly as the Librarian for the Johnson Elementary School (JES), at a 1 FTE, M45 Step 12, annual salary amount of \$71,705.

P. Beattie shared that D. Manning was invited to discuss Norah Connolly's teaching experience.

David shared that he was excited to have a level 2 candidate who has taught for many years in VT public schools. Norah currently works in Lowell as the school Librarian as well as performing IT duties. Norah is also Lowell's Local Union Representative. David is confident that JES will benefit from Norah's IT experience and from her experience working as the Union Representative.

Motion made by B. Bezio and seconded by S. Sweet.

T. Sweet asked if everyone was in favor of hiring N. Connolly. All present were in favor.

There being no further discussion, T, Sweet called the vote.
