

Honoring Students: Silver/White Cords

“Dept. Cord of Distinction”

Visual Arts: Student must receive 4 credits in the Visual Arts classes with nothing lower than an A- and participated in the Superintendent’s High School Art Show.

Music: 4 credits in music, nothing below an A- in those classes, submitted or participated at state level. Highlighters.

Math/English/Social Studies/Science:

Students must be taking an AP class and receive nothing lower than an A- for all 4 years.

World Language: Must take a foreign language all 4 years of high school, and/or two years of a dual credit class and receive nothing below an A-. (A dual-credit class is College in the High School and AP)

C.T.E. courses: Two credits in one CTE Pathway, completing the highest level course available with an A.

NJROTC: Rank of Chief Petty Officer, must be a completer, and have nothing below an A- in the required classes.

Acting: 4 credits in theatre classes with nothing below an A- and completed in 3 productions outside of school.

P.E.: 4 years of P.E. classes, nothing below an A-

AVID: All 4 years
