AKRON CHILDREN'S SCHOOL HEALTH SERVICES

Akron Children's School Health Services will be hosting an immunization clinic during school hours on 5/8/24 for 6-12th grade students. The immunizations being offered are Meningococcal and TDAP immunizations are required for students entering 7th grade and an additional dose of the Meningococcal is required for students entering 12th grade. Additionally, we will be offering Gardasil (HPV) and Meningitis B (only 16 years old and older) as optional recommended immunizations. If you have questions, please call the office. 

While activity programs are sometimes referred to as extracurricular, they are, in fact, an extension of the classroom and are the "Other Half of Education."


