NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION**

POLICY NUMBER: 428

POLICY TITLE: Staff and Student Use of Artificial Intelligence (AI)

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: This policy has been written to provide guidance on the use of artificial intelligence (AI) within Volusia County Schools.

SUMMARY OF THE ECONOMIC IMPACT ON THIS POLICY: There is no economic impact on any agency or individual other than the cost of promulgating and disseminating this policy.

CONSIDERATION BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF VOLUSIA COUNTY: The proposed action will be considered by the School Board of Volusia County at the meeting to be held by the School Board on May 14, 2024 at the DeLand Administrative Complex, 200 North Clara Avenue, DeLand, Florida. The School Board shall set aside time for the purpose of receiving comment on the proposed action on or about 5:30 p.m. Speakers will be given up to three minutes to provide comment, in accordance with Volusia County School Board Policy 801. If any affected person under section 120.54, Florida Statutes, would like to request a hearing in order to present evidence and argument on any issue under consideration in the revision of the policy, he/she must submit such request in writing to the Agency Clerk, Ms. Celeste Gilmore, at 200 North Clara Avenue, DeLand, Florida, 32720. The request must be received by the Agency Clerk no later than 5 p.m., May 13, 2024.
