Algebra II	June 2026	January 2026
Chemistry*	June 2026	June 2027
Physics*	June 2026	June 2027
English Language Arts	June 2026	January 2026

* For science, the new learning standards are not as strongly aligned to the prior standards. As a result, there will be an overlap period of the old and new exams for four administrations. This will ensure that students can complete the exam that matches the instruction they received.

Regents Investigations

Performance-based tasks that are a component of the State's strategy for assessing science.

Emphasize PEs that will not be measured at the level of proficiency on the written assessment and ensure these PEs are incorporated into instruction.

The level of understanding of the aligned PEs (SEPs, DCIs, and CCCs) required for the Investigations does not make them well suited to functioning as initial instructional tools.



There will be 3 Required Investigations per Regents Level Science Course. Materials <u>memo</u> can be found on OSA website.
