


# **Age and Birth Verification Document Examples**

Prior to a student's admission, the parent/guardian shall submit *proof of the child's age* (Education Code 48002) *that identifies the parent/guardian*. To fulfill this requirement, you may supply:

### 1. Birth Certificate

- 2. A combination of one of the following documents, which includes the student's name and date of birth, <u>PLUS</u> a completed <u>Affidavit for Proof of Age of Minor</u> to verify legal parent/guardian names.
  - e.g., Passport and Affidavit for Proof of Age of Minor



## 3. Affidavit for Proof of Age of Minor

- This form is used either when you can't supply a birth certificate, or when you have another document that doesn't show the parent or guardian's name, as explained in Section 2.
  - Once the affidavit is complete, this document shall serve as a verification of age document (keep a copy of the affidavit as part of the pupil's mandatory permanent record). The affidavit may also be used to confirm a child's legal name and date of birth as part of the permanent compulsory record school districts must maintain by Section 432 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations.
  - A parent/legal guardian requesting to amend information on a previously submitted affidavit must submit an official document supporting the change.
