General Impressions from Focus Groups

The Lakeview School District is a progressive district that is moving in the right direction. There is a strong commitment to educating ALL students. Led by a dedicated, caring staff and a strong administrative team, it is obvious that each student's education is at the forefront of all decisions. The high quality teaching staff was cited often for their caring attitude toward students, the rapport that they have with students, and their dedication to student learning. Other staff members were also recognized for their roles in making Lakeview a caring place for students. In addition to a strong academic commitment, there are a variety of high quality extracurricular activities including music, fine arts, math team, and mock trial.

The Lakeview School District has the support of staff, parents, community and students. Both parents and community members expressed interest in finding ways that they could provide more support to the district.

Both the school and sports complex facilities were frequently referred to with pride. There were many reports of the support of community members at athletic and fine arts events. There is a lot of school pride exhibited by students, staff, parents, and community members.

Having pre-K through 12th grade in one building is seen as a benefit to all students. The interactions between older and younger students are seen as positive. Older students acknowledged the need to be good role models for younger students. Parents reported that younger students appreciated the opportunities to interact with the older students.

The Lakeview School District is seen as a safe and welcoming place for students, staff, parents and community. Students report that there is very little bullying going on and when it does occur, it is dealt with.

While overall the Lakeview School District does a good job, there is a definite commitment to continuous improvement. Teachers continue to look for ways to increase student learning. They are supported by an administration that is open to trying new things.

Areas for improvement would be:

- Communication, especially with community members
- Assuring students have the financial and life skills needed for the future
