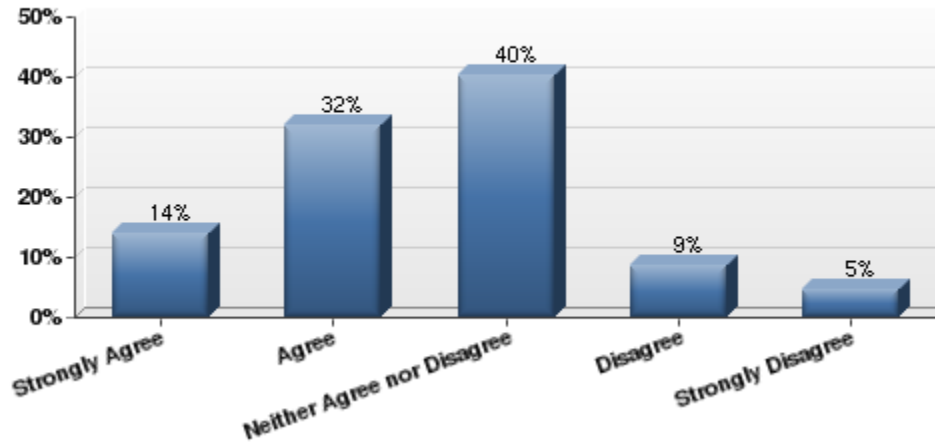

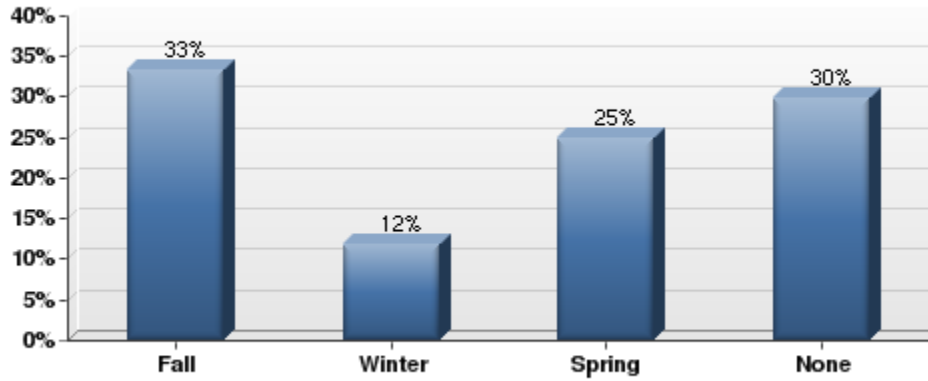

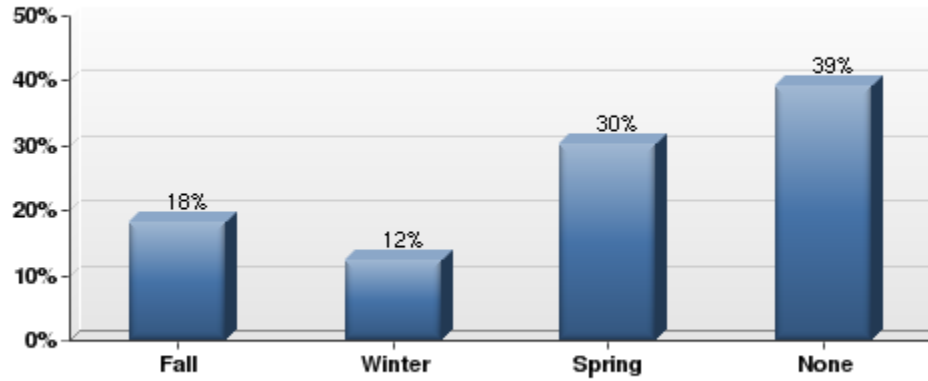

5. Most positively affected: (Select One)



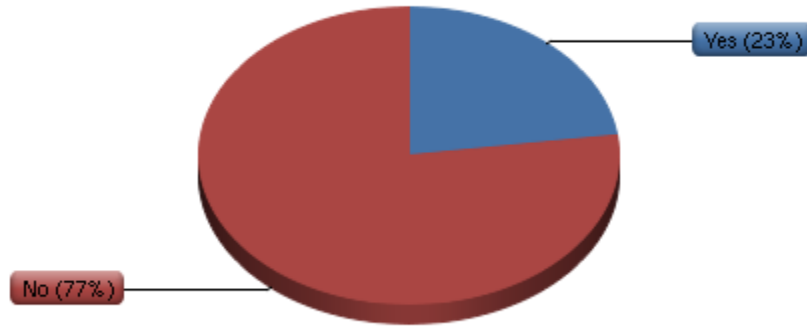

6. Most negatively affected: (Select One)



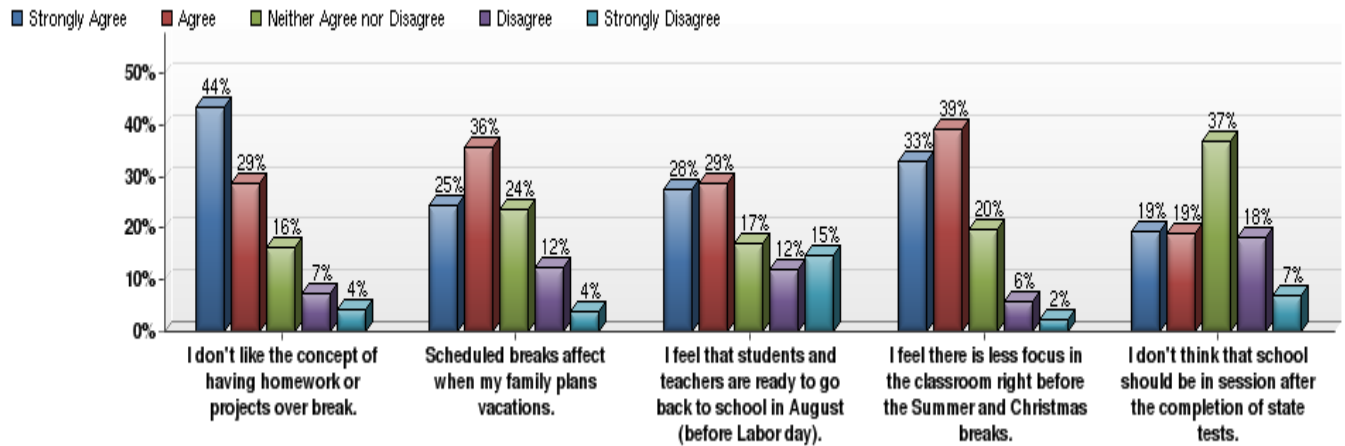

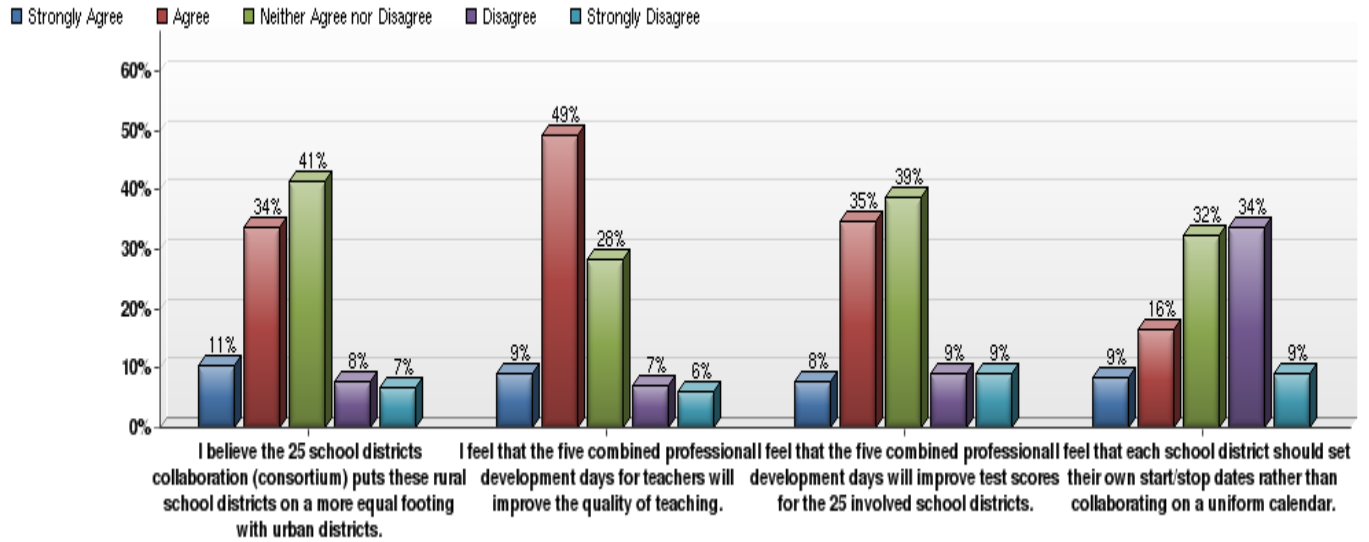

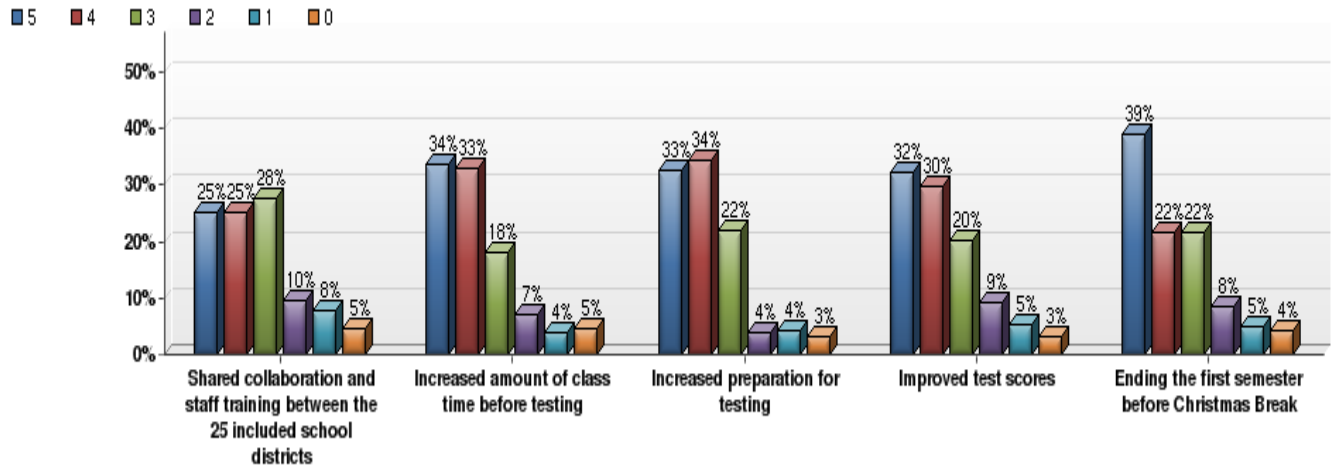

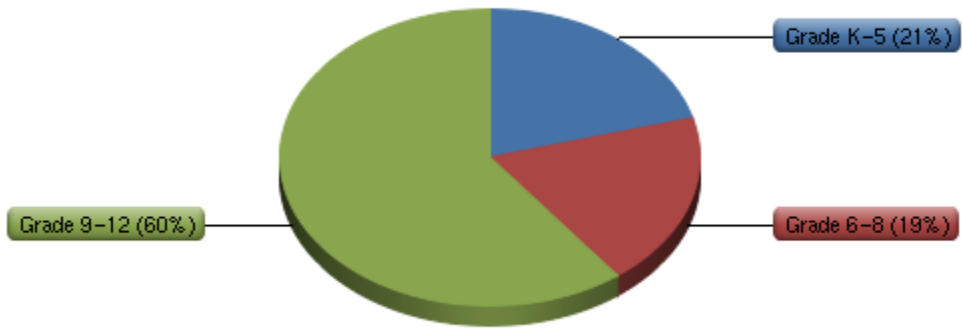
