	232. STUDENT INVOLVEMENT IN DECISION-MAKING
1. Purpose	<p>The Joint Committee believes that students should participate in the governance of school activities at levels appropriate to their ages and competencies because:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. As part of their educational development, students should be provided experiences and decision-making roles to prepare them for the future.2. Students are a valuable resource whose contributions can aid and benefit the programs of the center.
2. Authority	<p>The Joint Committee directs that students be invited to participate in activities appropriate to their maturity and competency, leading to administrative decision-making.</p> <p>Suggestions for improvement of the school may be offered by any student, provided they are of a constructive nature and contribute toward the realization of the center's educational goals.</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Director or designee shall develop rules to implement this policy which:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Provide for submission, consideration, and response to constructive student suggestions.2.
