






# Gold colored thermostat found in many schools

PROGRAMMING THE THERMOSTAT



KEYS USED FOR SETTING THE CLOCK

#### TO SET THE CLOCK

- 1. Press the CLOCK key.
- Press the + or key until the display shows the correct time.

#### NOTES:

The + and - keys adjust the clock ahead and back, respectively.

As you approach the correct time, repeatedly tap the + or - key to adjust minutes one at a time.

## Another common thermostat found in many schools



- 1. Press Set Current Day/Time (green arrow)
- 2. Press *Up or Down arrows* until correct time is displayed (purple arrow)
- 3. If needed, press Day to set the current day.



## Only found in 2 or 3 schools






Fig. 1. Thermostat key locations.


When using the keypad to change the day/time:

 Press Set Day until the current day is displayed.

> NOTE: Sun = Sunday, Mon = Monday, Tue = Tuesday,

Wed = Wednesday, Thu = Thursday, Fri = Friday, Sat = Saturday.

- 2. Press Set Time.
- Press up ▲ or down ▼ until the current time is displayed.





This thermostat is found in "new" portables.

## Follow the steps below to set the day of the week and current time:

- 1. Open the bottom flap and press **MENU**
- 2. Press **SET TIME**
- 3. Day of the week will be flashing. Use the + or key to select the current day of the week.
- 4. Press **NEXT STEP**
- 5. The current hour is flashing. Use the + or key to select the current hour.

  When using 12-hour time, make sure the correct a.m. or p.m. choice is selected.
- 6. Press **NEXT STEP**
- 7. Minutes are now flashing. Use the + or key to select current minutes.
- 8. Press **DONE** when completed
