

## ECISD Bond Committee Meeting #3 – August 31, 2021

### Key Table Takeaways regarding Elementary and Middle Schools

- Committee members consistently noted that capacity issues at middle schools needs to be addressed.
- The committee is interested in building new schools and replacing old schools rather than renovating old schools.
- New campuses are needed on the north, east and west sides of town.
- Several committee members stated that three new middle schools are needed. North, east and west sides of town.
- Many committee members stated that two new middle schools are needed.
- Some committee members stated that two new elementary schools are needed in the west and northeast areas of the district.
- Some committee members stated that four new elementary schools are needed. Two schools up north and two out west.
- Multiple tables stated that they preferred to see no major renovations to old schools.
- Preferred to replace and consolidate old elementary campuses.
- Replace Wilson & Young and Bonham.
- Need two new middle schools (west and northeast).
- Possibly repurpose Ector for a CTE facility.
- Replace Carver.
- Renovate all restrooms in older buildings that will not be replaced – especially Bowie, Bonham and Alamo.
- ECISD needs to go out for a bond every three years just to get caught up on facility needs.
- Get rid of portables.
- Renovate and update Nimitz and Bowie.
- Replace Dowling, Zavala, Travis, Wilson & Young, and Bonham.
- Repurpose Ross for Administrative purposes and current student would go to Goliad and/or Ireland.
- Replace Goliad and Bonham.
- Renovate Ector.
- Build a long-term plan for replacing older schools.
- Repurpose an underutilized campus, such as Ross, to an early education facility and do away with Carver.
- Renovating facilities shouldn't be an option due to the high costs associated.
