Enrollment Pathways

ECISD offers multiple ways for families living in our attendance zone to access our schools. Families enroll through one of several pathways:


- Complete registration for a Neighborhood School
- Submit a Choice Application HS (Oct. 10-Jan.15) Elem./Middle Schools (Dec.1 Jan.15)
- Submit a Pre-K Application
- Receive a Referral

Means that families can enroll in Sample Middle School if they live in that middle school's attendance zone or submit a transfer request.

Sample ES



Means that families can enroll in Sample Elementary School by submitting a Pre-K application or speaking with a school counselor for a referral.



Zoned School

Zoned schools have a designated attendance zone. They offer great programs and have certified teachers in a convenient location for families. Students living in the attendance zone are guaranteed enrollment. Choice Application

Choice Schools are specialized offerings typically showcasing a model around which all teaching and learning happens, such as STEM, Dual Language, International Baccalaureate, or Montessori. These can be neighborhood schools. Choice applications can be submitted online under Choice Schools.



Transfer Request

Students living in and out of ECISD who want to attend a different neighborhood school may submit a transfer request as outlined in FDB (LEGAL). Transfer approval depends on space availability, program availability (pending special needs), and campus capacity. For help submitting a transfer request, call the Office of Admissions at (432) 554-2410.



Pre-K Application

ECISD has several locations for early childhood learning opportunities that provide a quality education and comprehensive social services. To submit an application for Pre-K contact the Early Childhood Department at (432) 456-0087.



By Referral

Some ECISD campuses are structured to address socialized needs of students, either life circumstances requiring alternative learning structures or by being identified through the special needs process. To be referred to a specific campus, families should speak with their child's counselor.

Overview

The Dual Language program at Cameron Elementary is a research-based educational program in which students learn a second language through academic instruction.

Cameron Elementary uses the 50/50 two-way immersion Dual Language model. Through this model, students receive English instruction 50% of the time and Spanish instruction 50% of the time. By 6th grade or before, students are bilingual, biliterate, and develop a cross-cultural awareness.

In addition, students learn French as a third language. The purpose of the third language is to expose students to a language and culture of another country. Learning takes place through songs, music, theatrical plays, and the arts.

Research indicates that students who attend a Dual Language program for at least 5 to 6 years become better problem-solvers, are more creative than monolingual students, and will be better prepared to contribute to the global economy of the 21st century.

Our 400+ students graduate with BOTH a high school diploma and an Associates Degree (60 or more college hours) from Odessa College by taking Dual Credit classes, which are tuition free. All students are issued a laptop to complete and submit most of their high school and college assignments.

Our students are taught by both high school teachers and by college professors, depending on the class and subject. High school classes are taught on the Honors level using the ECISD Honors curriculum. OCA students meet regularly with our high school academic counselor and our dual credit college counselor to ensure they are on track to graduate with both degrees.
