All Title I, Part A paraprofessionals with instructional duties and teaching in a program supported by Title I, Part A funds, have a high school diploma or its equivalent and meet the Title I, Part A qualifications based on their (1) completion of 2 years of education at an institution of higher education, or (2) earning an associate's (or higher) degree, or (3) having met a rigorous standard of quality through a formal local academic assessment that assesses the knowledge of and the ability to assist in instructing reading readiness, writing readiness, and mathematics readiness, as appropriate.

_____ 2. I understand that documentation will be maintained to support any Title I, Part A paraprofessionals with instructional duties assigned and ensure paraprofessional requirements have been met. The following exceptions are:

- Paraprofessionals who are proficient in English and a language other than English and who provide services primarily to enhance the participation of children in Title I, Part A programs by acting as a translator
- Paraprofessionals whose duties consist solely of conducting parent engagement activities consistent with Public Law 114-95, Section 1116 are not required to meet the highly qualified requirements for paraprofessionals).

_____ 3. I understand that paraprofessionals with instructional duties and working in a program supported with Title I, Part A funds will be assigned to:

- Provide one-on-one tutoring for eligible students if the tutoring is scheduled at a time when a student would not otherwise receive instruction from a teacher.
- Assist with classroom management, such as organizing instructional and other materials.
- Assist in a computer laboratory.
- Conduct parent engagement activities.
- Provide support in a library or media center.
- Act as a translator.
- Provide instructional services to students by statute.

_____4. I understand that paraprofessionals who assume limited duties beyond classroom instruction or duties that do not benefit participating children are not working in a program supported with Title I, Part A funds. The amount of time spent on such duties with the same proportion of total work time exists concerning similar personnel at the same school.

_____5. I understand that paraprofessionals in Title I, Part A programs providing instructional services to students are working under the direct supervision of a teacher where:

- The teacher plans the instructional Federal and State Program activities.
- The teacher evaluates the achievement of the student.
- The paraprofessional works in close and frequent physical proximity to the teacher.
