- FOR ALL STUDENTS <u>WIRELESS MOUSE OR CORDED MOUSE FOR LAPTOP</u>. OCA HAS LEARNED THAT THE TOUCHPAD ON THE LAPTOP CAN WEAR OUT IF OVERLY USED. MOST STUDENTS USE A WIRELESS MOUSE BECAUSE IT IS MUCH EASIER & FASTER TO USE, HAVE LESS ERRORS ON ASSIGNMENTS, EASIER TO COMPLETE STARR & MAP TESTS, AND IT EXTENDS THE LONGEVITY OF THE LAPTOP.
- **Student will need a large, sturdy backpack.** We recommend a large one that will hold their school issued Laptop and other materials including pens, pencils, markers, spirals, and composition notebooks. Students can choose the color and style of their backpack as long as it is big and sturdy enough to hold all their daily supplies. It must be brought to school every day with their supplies.
- Also, purses, small clutches, or other bags will be limited to those that measure 5 x 8 x 1. No other bags will be allowed to be carried to school, except for the laptop bag that is given to you by OCA.
- If students choose to wear a mask at school, they need to bring their own. Our campus nurse has some masks to use in extenuating circumstances, but supplies are limited. Hand sanitizer will be available in all classrooms. Students can bring and keep their own hand sanitizer in their backpacks.
- Student Planner students will be given a free student planner in their AVID class. This is to keep up with all their assignments in their 8 classes. Student planners will be checked & graded each 9 weeks to ensure students are keeping organized with all their assignments. If students wish to purchase their own planner, we ask they wait until AFTER they receive their AVID planner, so they will know what to look for in a store bought one. NOTE ALL OCA students will be required to keep an organization system for planning purposes. OCA AVID will be visiting a new electronic system of planners once school begins.
- 2 Tissue / Kleenex Boxes. We will collect these the 1st day of school as students arrive to school. This will help us ensure we have tissue in all classrooms distributed throughout the school year.
- Black, blue, and red pens, and mechanical pencils (no regular pencils)

- Graph paper for high school math classes Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, or Algebraic Reasoning
- Students taking Art I, II, III, IV, or Art Appreciation one 9x12 sketch book, \$25 art fee for Art I and \$35 art fee for Art II, III, or IV. The art fee will be collected by Mr. Golden, the Art teacher.
- Students taking 10th Grade Chemistry or 12th Grade Forensics 1 inch 3 ring binder. Nothing bigger.
 No spirals for Chemistry or Forensics.
- Students taking 11th Grade Physics 1 composition notebook, protractor, 12 inch ruler, 1 pack of 4 double AA batteries, scientific calculator (wait until you attend class so you will know which calculator for Physics), 1 package of graphing paper, 1 package of 3x3 post-it notes, 1 package of 3x5 index cards, 1 small bottle of Elmer's glue, 1 roll scotch tape
