### CAREER EXPLORATION

All students begin exploring their career interests as early as elementary school using their Naviance career exploration resources

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### EDUCATIONAL PLANNING

All students participate in educational planning with their middle school and high school counselors. They get to align their career interests to programs of study and create a 4 year plan.

### DUAL CREDIT, AP, & IB

Starting in 9th grade, all students are able to register for College dual credit, AP, or IB courses. They can earn college credit while in High school and work on an associate degree plan with their high school counselor.

### BUSINESS & INDUSTRY CERTIFICATIONS

Students can request CTE (Career & Technical Education) courses within a program of study that aligns with their career interests. These programs often come with college credit and business & industry certifications.

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### CONTINUED EDUCATIONAL PLANNING

#### WITH COUNSELORS

Students revisit their 4 year plans and course selections with counselors throughout high school to make sure their interests are still aligned with their course selections and post secondary plans.

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### COLLEGE, CAREER, OR MILITARY PLANNING

Students work with high school counselors, CCMR Advisors, College Admissions staff and military recruiters to complete applications, scholarship applications, or begin the process of military enlistment.

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### GRADUATION WITH CCMR ACCOMPLISHED!

All students graduate with one of the following:

- Meets TSI criteria
- 9 or more hours dual credit
- Passing score on a Core AP course
- Earns Associate Degree
- Earns an Industry-based certification
- Enlists in the U.S. Armed Forces
