What is National Board Certification?

- Recognized as the "Gold Standard" in teacher certification.
- Provides a framework for what accomplished teachers should know and be able to do.

Why Become a National Board Certified Teacher?

- Students taught by NBCTs show greater gains.
- Impactful Professional Development
- All Students in ECISD deserve to be taught by accomplished teachers
- Teacher Incentive Allotment of \$3,000 to \$9,000

Who is Eligible?

- Teachers, counselors and media specialist that have:
 - A Bachelor's Degree (except some CTE teachers)
 - 2 Years teaching experience in the U.S.
 - A state teaching certificate

What is the Certification Process?

- Submit 4 Components to National Board over 2 years
 - Component 1: Content Knowledge ("The Test")
 - Component 2: Differentiation in Instruction
 - Component 3: Teaching Practice and Learning Environment
 - Component 4: Effective and Reflective Practitioner

What is the Cost to the Teacher?

- Teacher is responsible for a \$75 registration fee each of the two years.
- Thanks to the Permian Strategic Partnership (PSP), component fees are paid for all 4 components (\$475 x 4 = \$1,900).
- PSP provides tutoring through the National Board Resource Center. (\$1,200 per year)
