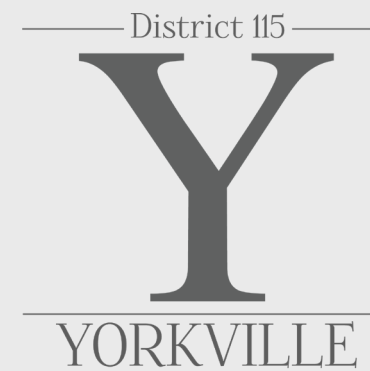

Technology Talk

1:1 Initiative A Chromebook for each student

The district distributes Dell Chromebooks to students in the 1:1 (1 student, 1 device) technology initiative. By the end of the initiative roll-out period, all students in grades 4-12 will be issued Chromebooks to enhance their classroom learning. Students use these devices in many different ways from researching topics in class, to accessing online courses. The Chromebooks are also used to access the many digital resources that the district provides.

Students receive new Chromebooks in grades 4, 7, and 10, as the Dell devices are leased on a three-year cycle. Employees of the Yorkville CUSD 115 Technology Department service and repair the Chromebooks.



Staying Safe Online

The district monitors all student Google accounts with "Gaggle." Gaggle is a monitoring tool that scans Gmail and Google Drive for inappropriate content. This ranges from inappropriate words or conversations to inappropriate images.

As an additional safety measure, the district also uses GoGuardian, an education-focused software management and web-filtering system, to monitor content on the Chromebooks. By using this software, the district has the ability to filter and block/unblock websites being accessed on district devices, no matter where in the world the Chromebooks are being used.



Student-Friendly Businesses

Almost 3,000 students are supplied with district-issued Chromebooks as part of the District 115 1:1 technology initiative. This expanse in technology is fully supported with accessible Wi-Fi in the schools, however, some students do not have access to a wireless network at home. In response, several community businesses have stepped up and offered students spaces with free Wi-Fi access where they are welcome to work on their learning activities. The following locations have been designated as "Student-Friendly" businesses.

Classroom Apps



ADOBE SPARK

A graphic design application to create images, videos, and web pages using Spark Page, Spark Post, and Spark Video.



CANVAS

An educational learning management system that connects digital tools and resources for use by educators, students, and parents.



CLASS DOJO

A classroom communication tool used to upload photos or videos, share behavior reports with parents, and use games to teach developmental skills through real-time feedback.



EDMODO

An educational tool that allows teachers to share content, distribute assignments, and manage communication with students and parents.



FLIPGRID

A video discussion platform in which students record, upload, view, react and respond to others' short videos.



GOOGLE CLASSROOM

A web application used by educators to manage assignments, provide feedback, and track a student's progress.



KAHOOT!

A game-based learning platform that allows teachers to create learning games with embedded videos, images, and diagrams.



NEARPOD

An interactive classroom tool that allows teachers to create interactive presentations, collaboration opportunities, and real-time assessments.



PERISCOPE

A live-video streaming application that allows users to watch and broadcast real-time videos.



SEESAW

A student-driven digital portfolio that allows students to independently document what they are learning at school.

FORTNITE

A survival game in which 100 players fight against each other in player-versus-player combat.



HOUSEPARTY

A group video chat app that allows users to talk simultaneously with up to eight friends through live video.



KIK

An anonymous instant messaging mobile app that allows users to send and receive messages, videos, and pictures to other Kik users, either one-to-one or in group chats with up to 49 other users.



MUSICALY

A platform to view and create short videos and live broadcasts of singing, dancing, comedy, and lip-syncing up to 15 seconds in length.



OMEGLE

An online chat website that randomly pairs strangers to socialize through text or webcam video with non-registered users.



PINTEREST

A search tool that primarily uses images to enable users to find and save ideas.



SNAPCHAT & SNAP MAP

A messaging app that allows users to share photos, short videos, text, and drawings that disappear seconds after the viewer opens them. Snap Map allows for location sharing.



TUMBLR

A microblogging platform that allows users to post multimedia content to a short-form blog.



VOXER

A Walkie-Talkie style push-to-talk messaging app with text, photo, and location sharing capabilities.



WHATSAPP

A Facebook-owned free instant messaging app that uses the Internet to send messages, images, audio, video, and location sharing to other users.



WHISPER

A mobile app that encourages users to “share their real feelings” anonymously by superimposing text over photo and video messages and sharing them through the app.



YOUTUBE

A platform through which users upload, view, and share videos.
