# **Playing Time**

- •Playing time/participation is up to the coach
- •Athletes are encouraged to have a discussion with the coach if there is a concern
  - "Chain of command"
  - Encourage your child to advocate for themselves
- Any parent meeting regarding playing time will involve the athletic director, parent, athlete, and coach

## **Eligibility**

- STUDENT-athletes
- Grades are checked every Friday morning
- Students who have one 'F' or more, will be ineligible to participate in games/meets the following week Monday-Sunday. They <u>CAN</u> still practice.
- The second week a student is ineligible, they still can't participate in games/meets, but still may practice.
- The third week a student in in eligible, there will be a parent meeting between coach, parent, and athletic director to determine possible removal from team.
- The coaches are willing to be flexible. If an athlete needs help from a teacher after school and may miss part of practice that is okay. They need to communicate that to a coach, though!

#### **Concussions**

- If an athlete is suspected of having a concussion, they will not be allowed to participate <u>OR ATTEND</u>
   <u>SCHOOL</u> until they are seen by a physician
- If an athlete is diagnosed with a concussion, they can return to practice/meets per doctor request (usually gradually over time).
- Always communicate with coaches and nurses
