Meeting Minutes Approved

- March's meeting minutes were approved by Jill Beane and Bridget Winz.

Meeting Topics:

CAC Membership

- Board positions descriptions and CAC member term expiration dates were provided.

Transition Team Planning

Scheduling, High School:

- Block scheduling was proposed
- Schedule adds SEL time, additional instruction minutes
- School day same length as current year; time is saved due to passing period reductions

Scheduling, Middle School:

- Blending portions of this year and previous year schedules
- 10 periods between 7:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m.
- Increase of math minutes from 42 to 65; same increase for ELA
- Advisory will be held at the same time for all students

Scheduling, Elementary Schools:

- Two recess periods will remain; a renewed push for outdoor learning
- All students to have 15 minutes SEL time
- Focus on rigor, play, and whole child
- Grades 4-5 will have math increased to 90 minute increments
- Grade 6 will have math increased to 85 minute increments

Summer Opportunities:

- District expanding opportunities to connect with students over the summer and reduce the learning gap from the pandemic
- Rising Mathematicians, Jump Start programs, Summer School, Camp Imagination, Camp Acceleration, Wellness camps will all be offered and will be in-person
- High school will offer 2 sessions over the summer, with enrichment by invitation opportunities based of PSAT scores
- Not all programs will offer transportation; only invitation-only camps will do so
