9th-11th Grade Spring Testing, Wednesday, April 10th

The YHS student services team is excited to announce the spring testing schedule for the College Board Suite of Assessments (PSAT and SAT with Essay) test for all 9th-11th grade students on Wednesday, April 10, 2024.

On April 10th, all 12th-grade students and students in the **Life and Academic Skills Program (LASP) WILL NOT BE IN ATTENDANCE**. Students in the RSSP program that are current 11th graders, will be in attendance and assigned a testing location.

All 9th-11th grade **students' testing location is their Access classroom** and should report to that location no later than 7:20 am on April 10th. Students with testing accommodations will receive direct communication regarding their testing location.

Below is the testing time summary and schedule 9th-11th grade students will follow after testing.

- Test: PSAT 9, Start Time: 7:25 am, End Time: 10:15 am, Bus Departure: 10:30 am
- Test: PSAT 10, Start Time: 7:25 am, End Time: 10:15 am, Bus Departure: 10:30 am
- Test: SAT with Essay, Start Time: 7:25 am, End Time: 11:15 am, Bus Departure: 11:30 am
- Accommodated Testing*, Start Time: 7:25am, End Time: varies, Bus Departure: varies

Any 9th-11th grade students who are absent on April 10th will be able to participate in the makeup practice assessment on Wednesday, April 23rd.

Student attendance is of the utmost importance to us as we continually work together toward students' pathways of success. It is important to ask your students to give their absolute best so please encourage them to get a good night's sleep, eat a well-balanced breakfast, and remind them to bring their

Chromebook charged with their charger and a calculator. Other key information you and your students need to know as they prepare for the SAT:

- Cell phones are prohibited in the testing environment.
- Eating or drinking during testing is not allowed, please be sure to eat a good breakfast and come to school well-rested.
- You may bring a water bottle or light snack to be consumed during break time only.
- Students with accommodations may be allowed snacks and will be advised of their alternative testing locations before testing.

Athletics Update

Boys and Girls Track Compete at Indoor SPC Meet!

The Yorkville Boys finished 6th at the Indoor Track and Field Meet at Lewis University on Friday, March 15th. 95% of athletes set personal records this indoor season and the trend continued at Conference with several boys putting out their best performances. Dominic Vashkelis-Benson kicked off the night taking 1st place in Shot Put. Ryan Stribiak also scored high in the event with his 4th place Shot Put finish. Jake Younger PR'd and earned himself 4th place in the 3200m run. Taelor Clements tied his own school record of 6' 7" in High Jump and finished 2nd place. Owen Horeni had a big evening finishing 3rd in the 800m, 4th in the 1600m and led off the 3rd place 4x400m relay that also had Dyllan Malone, Ben Kozial, and Ethan Malas. The Conference meet capped off a great indoor season for the Yorkville Boys and we're looking forward to the outdoor season!

The Foxes had a good day at the Girls SPC Indoor Track & Field Meet at Lewis University on Saturday, March 16. At the meet, 18 girls had PRs in eight different events and 11 of those girls scored points in seven events. Our top placer was Courtney Clabough who earned a 2nd place finish in the shot put. Other point scorers included the 3rd place 4x800 relay team of Sophia Keeler, Anabelle Reeder, Ava Galloway, and Lily Camargo. Kailey Davey and Cassidy Madden tied for 4th place in the high jump, Cassia Bonga (long jump), Taylynn Stewart (55m hurdles), Allegra Triner (400m), and Lily Camargo (800m) all also finished with 6th place finishes in their respective events. This meet marked the end of the Indoor Season for most of our athletes but a few will continue next weekend as qualifiers for the Illinois Prep Top Times meet at Illinois Wesleyan University. Best of luck to Courtney Clabough competing in shot put, Allegra Triner competing in the 800, and the 4x800 relay team of Sophia Keeler, Allegra Triner, Lily Camargo, and Anabelle Reeder! The rest of the Foxes will be back in competition on Saturday, April 6th at the Downers Grove South Invite.

He began releasing music with Monstercat in 2015 and has quickly grown to become a widely recognized figure in the bass music scene, known for his distinguished take on trap and dubstep, alongside other styles. Swartwout is currently on tour with REAPER for his CHALLENGER tour, hitting dates in Chicago, Madison, and Los Angeles, to name a few. He also currently teaches Music Production at The Los Angeles Film School.

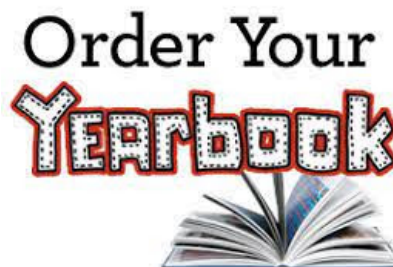

Advanced Placement Testing Information for the 2023-2024 School Year



Students who are currently enrolled in an Advanced Placement (AP) Course are required to take the end of the year exam. Exams are administered at YHS and follow the College Board's national exam schedule. Students must test on the assigned exam day for their course. Please become familiar with the exam day schedule. [2024 Exam Schedule](#)

Please note the test day highlights and special considerations:

1. The AP exam is required for all students participating in an AP course THIS school year.
2. Morning exams start at 7:30 am and afternoon exams start at 11:30 am.
3. All AP students will be pre-excused for testing and there is no need to call the attendance office on exam day.
4. Students will primarily be testing in the Academy Back GYM unless noted on schedule. Students MUST park in their assigned parking spot. Students report directly to testing for morning exam sessions.
5. Students are responsible for transportation for afternoon exams. *Some exams run after 2:35 pm.
6. If your lunch period is missed due to testing you will be allowed to eat lunch prior to testing or after testing is completed for the day. No pass is needed. Lunch will be available early for PM testers in the main campus cafeteria (limited selection).
7. If your student has a morning and afternoon exam on one day they must participate in both exams and will be allowed to eat lunch in the testing room in between exams.
8. **Students need to inform their AP teacher if they have more than one scheduled exam at the SAME time for either a morning or afternoon session prior to March 15th.**
9. **Students with College Board approved accommodations for AP testing must request accommodations prior to March 15th to Jeannine Pacetti at jpacetti@y115.org.**
10. Students are expected to attend classes before or after testing. AP test proctors will not excuse students home for the day if classes are in session.

Students will need the following items on test day:

1. #2 Wooden Pencil, Calculator, Black or Blue Ink Pen
2. Student ID
3. **College Board Identification Number. *This will be provided in advance by the AP Coordinator via the AP teacher. Students must come to EVERY exam with this number.**
4. Water bottle or light lunch if participating in morning and afternoon testing on one day.
