Types of Early Childhood programming offered by Y115:

Special Education Classroom Services—for students who demonstrate developmental delays, are in need of an Individualized Education Plan and may benefit from classroom support services such as Speech, Occupational, or Physical Therapy.

Preschool for All—Needs based determined through the use of eligibility criteria such as developmental concerns, income, high mobility, identified risk factors, or unique family circumstance.

Walk-in Speech— for students who benefit from speech and language support but are not interested or do not qualify for Preschool for All.
