**ACCIDENT REPORT
3RD QUARTER
2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR**

A TOTAL OF 38 INJURIES WERE REPORTED THROUGH THE THIRD QUARTER OF THE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR WITH 5 OF THE INJURIES RESULTING IN "LOST TIME" FROM WORK.

SCHOOL SPRING SAFETY

Assess Equipment Safety: Regularly assess the state of the school's equipment to ensure everything is safe and in good working order. Do safety checks on playground equipment, gym equipment, carbon monoxide alarms, fire alarms, door locks, heating and cooling systems and the kitchen appliances in the cafeteria.

2. *Always remember all accidents are preventable.*
3. *Always follow company rules, regulations and procedures.*
4. *Always assess the risks. Stop and think.*
5. *Always be proactive about safety.*
6. *Always deter from situations you're not trained to handle.*
7. *Always manage the lift.*
8. *Always be prepared.*
9. *Always practice good housekeeping.*
10. *Always take the safest path, never take shortcuts.*

SPRING SAFETY TIPS

- Check the weather before leaving the house. You may encounter several types of weather in one day.
- Wear non-slip shoes to prevent slipping on wet floors.
- Keep an umbrella in your car, just as you would keep an ice scraper during the winter.
- Use handrails when climbing stairs, especially if your shoes are wet.
- Avoid walking through grass and dirt as this interferes with the traction on your shoes and can cause a slip.
