SAFETY FIRST: REMINDERS

Parents should drive AROUND the building (following the designated car lane) to drop students and pick students up in the afternoons at EXIT 2 ON-LY.

All car-riders will be dismissed at Exit 2 in the afternoons and are expected to be dropped off there as well.

ALL morning drop off should happen at EXIT 2, using the car lane and driving all the way around the building. This includes choir, band and orchestra.

Students should never be let out of vehicles in the parking lot containing school bus traffic.

Crossing guards will be available to assist walkers.
