University of Alabama

800-933-2262 (Admissions Counselor)

21 minimum ACT (1000 SAT) with 3.0 OVERALL GPA, however all applications are considered on an individual basis. Writing portion of ACT is required. Algebra II is required. 1 yr Foreign Language is required. Must apply online or download forms. Minimums to qualify for scholarships are 27 ACT and 3.5 GPA. Scholarship deadline is December 15.

University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB)

20 ACT (950 SAT) & 2.25 overall GPA. 17 core credits required with 4 yrs English, 3 yrs Social Science, 3 yrs Science (including 2 labs), 3 yrs math (Algebra I & higher), 1 yr foreign language, and 3 additional academic courses. Priority deadline for admission is December 1. Minimums to qualify for scholarships are 20 ACT and 3.5 overall GPA. Scholarship deadline is December 1. December ACT score will be considered for scholarship if student is already admitted and requests UAB to pull their score. Honors Academy deadline is Dec 1.(?)

University of Alabama in Huntsville (UAH)

chantelle.tickles@uah.edu). 20 ACT and a 2.9 GPA are the minimum requirements for admissions. Engineering requires a minimum 21 composite on the ACT. Foreign Language is not required. A 25 on the ACT and 3.0 GPA are the minimum for MERIT BASED Scholarships (accept updated ACT scores through June 1).

18 ACT and 2.0 overall GPA. Algebra II is not required. Foreign Language is not required. Minimums to qualify for scholarships are 23 ACT and 3.25 overall GPA.

2.0 GPA and 18 ACT and high school diploma. However, a lower ACT would require a higher GPA, and lower GPA would require higher ACT. Algebra II not required. 1 yr Foreign Language OR Computer is required. Minimums to qualify for scholarships are 3.0 GPA and 20 ACT by February 15.

Auburn University 800-282-8769 (Kali Tucker, Admissions Counselor)

Admission application opens on September 1. Applicants are reviewed on an individual basis. The average GPA for students admitted to the 2013 freshman class was a 3.8 and the average ACT score was 27.2. Writing portion of ACT is required. Students are welcome to discuss their credentials with the admissions counselor, Kali Tucker. She can be reached at 334-844-8177 or by email at kat0003@auburn.edu. Minimums for automatic scholarships are 28 ACT (or comparable SAT) and 3.5 GPA. Scholarship deadline is February 15. A separate scholarship application is required after your admission to AU.

Auburn University at Montgomery 334-244-3842 (Lauran Fletcher, Admissions Counselor)

Minimum 18 ACT and 2.3 GPA for admission. Algebra II is not required. Foreign Language is not required. ONLINE application is free. Minimum qualifications for scholarships are 20 ACT and 3.5 GPA. Scholarship deadline is March 1.

Birmingham-Southern College 226-4696 (Anna Bodenhamer, Admissions, 226-4695 office number)

Average ACT is a 26.5 and average grade point average is 3.50. Applications are available via BSC online application or Common App. Essay required, recommendation form and letter, resume, transcript and application fee of \$50. Application fee waived if application is received by October 15. Early action (non-binding) deadline is November 15, and regular admission deadline is February 1. Merit scholarships are awarded based on where student falls in the BSC scholarship grid (which can be found here:<http://www.bsc.edu/admission/scholarships.cfm>) as well as a holistic approach. Evaluations begin November 15. All ACT/SAT scores sent by admission deadline will be considered. ACT and SAT scores are super-scored. Students are encouraged to apply for need based financial aid by completing the FAFSA.

Huntingdon College 800-763-0313 (Jenny McDavid, Admissions Counselor)

20 ACT, 930 SAT and an academic 2.5 GPA. Conditional acceptance can occur by individual evaluation. Two math courses above Algebra I are strongly recommended. Foreign Language not required, but recommended. Minimum to qualify for scholarships is acceptance to the college.

Jacksonville State University 800-231-5291 (Shelley Kaler, Admissions Counselor)

High School diploma or GED certificate required with at least a 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale. 20 ACT-unconditional acceptance; 18-19 ACT-student must take LS 104 Learning Skills class for remediation. SAT: 950 or above—unconditional acceptance; 870-940—conditional acceptance. Algebra II not required for admission, but

recommended. Foreign Language not required. Scholarship deadline is March 1 (February is last ACT considered w/scores being sent directly to JSU) and minimums to qualify are 22 ACT for automatic scholarships and 20 ACT and 2.5 GPA for Leadership Scholarships. Students must apply for admission and pay app. fee before applying for scholarships or housing.

Judson College 800-447-9472 (Tyne Olkie, Admissions Counselor)

18 ACT (870 SAT) and 2.0 academic GPA. If not meeting either of these requirements, you can apply to the Admissions Committee for possible Conditional Admission approval. Algebra II not required, but recommended. Foreign Language not required, but recommended. Minimums to qualify for scholarships are 20 ACT and 2.5 GPA. ACT scores through June will be considered for scholarships.

Miles College 929-1655 (Omar Young, Admissions Counselor)

Unconditional admittance given with a high school diploma. Those who do not make at least a 16 on each category of the ACT will fall into the Jump Start Program. Algebra II is not required. Foreign Language is not required. Minimums to qualify for scholarships are 18 ACT and 3.0 GPA.

University of Mobile 251-442-2222 (Kayla Roberts, Admissions Counselor)

21 ACT and 2.75 GPA for unconditional acceptance. They consider lower scores for conditional acceptance---contact admissions counselor. Algebra II is not required. Foreign Language is not required. Minimum scholarship requirements are 20 ACT and 2.75 GPA, and they consider ACT scores up until freshman year begins.

University of Montevallo 665-6030 (Greg Embry, Admissions Counselor)

20 ACT (SAT 850), 2.5 overall GPA. Algebra II not required for admission, but recommended. Foreign Language not required for admission, but recommended. Minimums to qualify for scholarships are 24 ACT and 3.0 GPA.

University of North Alabama 800-825-5862 (Julie Taylor, Associate Director of Admissions)

Unconditional admittance with an 18 ACT (870 SAT), GPA of "C" or 2.00 on academic core with a total of 13 core units. Conditional admission with: 16 on ACT (770 on SAT), at least 11 core units (4 English, 2 Math, 2 Natural or Physical Science, 3 Social Studies), and GPA of 1.75 on academic core. Algebra II is not required. Foreign Language is not required. Minimums to qualify for ACADEMIC scholarships are 20 ACT and 2.75 GPA. Scholarship deadline is December 15, after which awards are based on fund availability.

Samford University 205-726-3673 (Jenn Debrecht Admissions Counselor)

Application components include: application, \$40 application fee, one academic letter of recommendation, official ACT/SAT score, high school GPA, and personal essay. The average range for the ACT is 23-29, SAT is 1080-1320, and GPA is 3.48-4.0. Algebra II is required. Foreign Language is recommended, but not required. The application committee values test scores and GPA, but takes a holistic view in considering a student for admission and scholarships. There is a separate scholarship application for leadership and presidential scholarship consideration. Revisions to the application and updated test scores will be accepted through the December 15th deadline for merit-based scholarship consideration.

University of South Alabama 800-872-5247 (Kristi Williams, Admissions Counselor)

20 ACT with a 2.0 GPA, or 19 ACT with a 2.5 GPA. Algebra 1, II, and Geometry are required. Foreign Language not required, but may be used as an advanced elective. Minimums to qualify for scholarships are 23 ACT and 3.0 GPA. Priority scholarship deadline is December 7, but funds are distributed until exhausted.

Spring Hill College 800-742-6704 or 251-380-3030 (Lauren Fugit, Admissions Counselor)

They work off rolling admissions and there is no application fee. High School diploma, official transcript, letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor. They do superscore the ACT/SAT. Recommended 20 ACT or 930 SAT and 2.5 GPA. Average of last year's incoming class was between a 22-27 ACT and a 3.4 GPA. If you have below a 20 ACT, then they will look closely at your GPA for possible admission. Algebra II is required for admission. Foreign Language is not required. Minimums to qualify for scholarships are 20 ACT and 2.5 GPA.

Troy University 334-670-3188 (Jennifer Gardner, Admissions Counselor)

Unconditional admittance given with a 20 ACT (950 SAT) and a 2.0 overall GPA. Conditional admittance is given with a 17-19 ACT (830 SAT) and 2.5 GPA. Algebra II is not required for admission. Foreign Language is not required for admission. Minimums to qualify for scholarships are 22 ACT and 3.0 GPA. The last ACT test date considered for Leadership scholarship is December, and February for Chancellor's and Millennium.

Tuskegee University 334-727-8500

21 ACT or 1000 SAT (Critical Reading and Math) and 3.0 overall GPA. Algebra II is not required. Foreign Language is not required. Minimums to qualify for scholarships are 23 ACT and 3.3 GPA. Some grants may be available at lower minimum ACT and GPA.

University of West Alabama 205-652-5552 (Brooke Luker, Admissions Counselor)

Unconditional admittance given with a 19 ACT and a C average. Conditional admittance given with a 17-18 ACT. Algebra II is not required for admission. Foreign Language is not required for admission. Minimums to qualify for scholarships are 19 ACT and 2.0 GPA.
