Superintendent Josh Hurt

- Things are going very well as we start the last few months of the school year. Plans are underway for 2024-25.
- Congratulations to DPP Allen Trotter for being recognized as the WBKO Hometown Hero. He was nominated by a parent and the segment aired earlier tonight.
- Congratulations to Cheyenne Garmon, who recently had a baby boy. Mom, dad, and son are doing great. Donna Caffee will fill in as our chief financial analyst while Cheyenne is on maternity leave.
- Action item 5A will put the new early graduation policy into action, which requires grads to be post-secondary ready.
- Item 5B is a first read only. No action is required. The policy sets guidelines for early entry into kindergarten.
- For item 5D, on bids for the athletic complex, I am asking you to table this item. Some of the projects did not receive a bid.
- Item 5E will wrap up the high school roof project, which we have had no issues with thus far.
- Item 5F will allow KISTA to surplus five of our oldest buses for us.
- If we except item 5I, the KETS offer of assistance for \$11,072, the district has to match it.


