North Arlington Public Schools – High Performing!

Good afternoon, community members.

Once every three years, the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) conducts a full audit of five major categories as part of the Quality Single Accountability Continuum (QSAC) report. The five categories, also known as District Performance Review (DPR) sections, include the following: Instruction and Program, Fiscal Management, Governance, Operations, and Personnel. Each of these categories are issued a score from 0-100 with a passing score identified as an 80. In order for a school district to be considered “High Performing,” each category must receive a score of an 80 or higher.


After the NJDOE’s thorough review of the aforementioned DPR sections, I’m proud to announce that the North Arlington Public School District has been designated as “High Performing” based on the following scores:

Instruction and Program (86)
Fiscal Management (100)
Governance (100)
Operations (98)
Personnel (100)

With these results, I’m also very proud to highlight a 2% increase in our Instruction and Program DPR section from our previous QSAC review.

As we all know, there is still a lot of work ahead of us in the coming years; however, these results are encouraging and a testament to everyone’s commitment to our students.
