

Emmett School District Superintendent's Report April 2024

District Updates

- Intersection Closed 12th and Substation: The district has sent out information regarding the
 closure of this intersection and construction that is anticipated to cause delays and traffic
 pattern changes through the end of the school year. I have attached the image and modified
 bus drop off and pick up at Carberry elementary school that will take place starting April 8,
 2024.
- Administration has indicated that certified job openings have a higher number of certified applicants than historically over the past few years.
- District ISAT Testing begins this month in grades 3rd through 11th grade
- Black Canyon High School Graduation May 23rd at 6:30 pm
- Emmett High School Graduation May 24th at 7:00 pm
 - Emmett High School Bleacher Project was partially funded by a local donation in supporting the bringing back of EHS graduation to Emmett
 - Cost to the District for this project to date is \$161,551.66
 - There was a private donation of \$100,000 for this project prior to starting this project.
- Summer Curriculum Updates in Mathematics and English Language Arts
 - Regional Math Center is working with Emmett to provide support for math K-12 during the 2024-2025 school year.
- Emmett School District Spring Newsletter is being mailed to all addresses in Gem County
 - o There will be one more Newsletter scheduled for mailing in late June or early July
- Math Pilot and Curriculum Adoption Grade 6-12 and Renewal of Envision Math Grades K5
 - Elementary Envision Math will be renewed for 2 additional years through 2027 per the request of K-5 instructors.
 - 6-12 are currently piloting curriculum from McGraw-Hill and Carnegie for the upcoming adoption cycle. There are copies of both here in the board room for review. The curriculum was also available for review by parents and the public during parent-teacher conferences in March.
 - The Curriculum team will make a recommendation to the board at the May meeting.
 - Secondary curriculum that we will continue to use for some upper-level courses will remain the same.
 - Trade Math is through MyMathLab
 - Statistics is an online subscription
 - College Algebra, PreCalculus/Calculus, and Trigonometry are through WebAssign



- February 8th School Closure
 - Makeup Days for grades 6th -12th grade
 - April 19th
- Carberry Elementary will be seeking approval to update the readerboard to an electronic display. They are working on the bid package and will present it to the board for review at the May Board Meeting
- Emmett Middle School will be presenting a project to build a Gaga Ball court next to the outdoor basketball court using student raised funds. They will bring the full presentation to the May Board meeting for review.
- 2024 Idaho Legislative Session
 - HB 521 School Modernization Fund has been signed by the Governor
 - HB766 Trailer Bill cleans up the language on HB521 regarding 5 day and 4 Day. The State Board will still be expected to set the minimum number of hours and days but the language says school must attest to hours OR days. Our adopted calendar is above the state minimum by a large number of hours.



District Maintenance Updates

- Fire Suppression line repair and replacement at Shadow Butte and Carberry. Inspection was completed to prepare for R and R in the summer.
- Initial Cost Estimates are being solicited for the EHS south parking lot paving
- EHS weightroom removal of the walls and updating of the HVAC system is scheduled to begin June 1 with a completion date of August 1st. Wright Brothers Construction was hired to complete this project
- All school fields have been sprayed and fertilized with weed abatement a priority this spring
- Tech is beginning the installation of an updated Public Announcement System at Sweet.
- Request for Qualification were solicited for the EHS field repair or replacement. If the board
 elects to hire the qualified company they will prepare a cost estimate for both Sod replacement
 and Turf. It will be at the time the board will have the opportunity to move forward with either
 option or table the project to a future time





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
