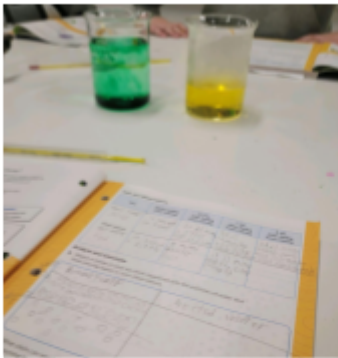


**Emmett Middle School

**Check out these Science labs**

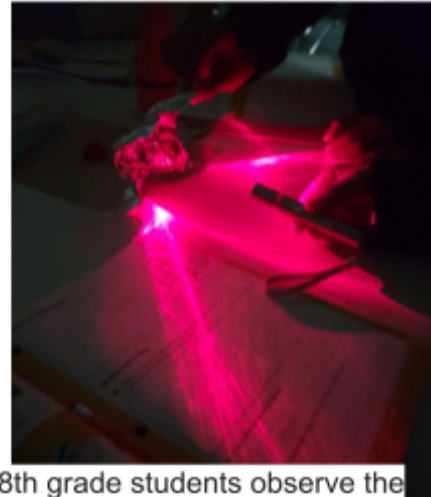

With each visit, she fortifies their skills for analytical reasoning. The students delight in delving into various scientific concepts during these sessions.

**Lab "Wait for it"**



6th grade Students provide evidence of particle movement in liquids with hot water and room temperature water with food coloring.

**Lab "The Rough Side"**



8th grade students observe the reflection of light from a rough surface to show diffuse reflection with lasers and aluminum foil.

**Lab "Two Sided"**



8th grade students observe the reflection of light on a convex and a concave surface with lasers and spoons to see the difference in the focal points for each surface.
