

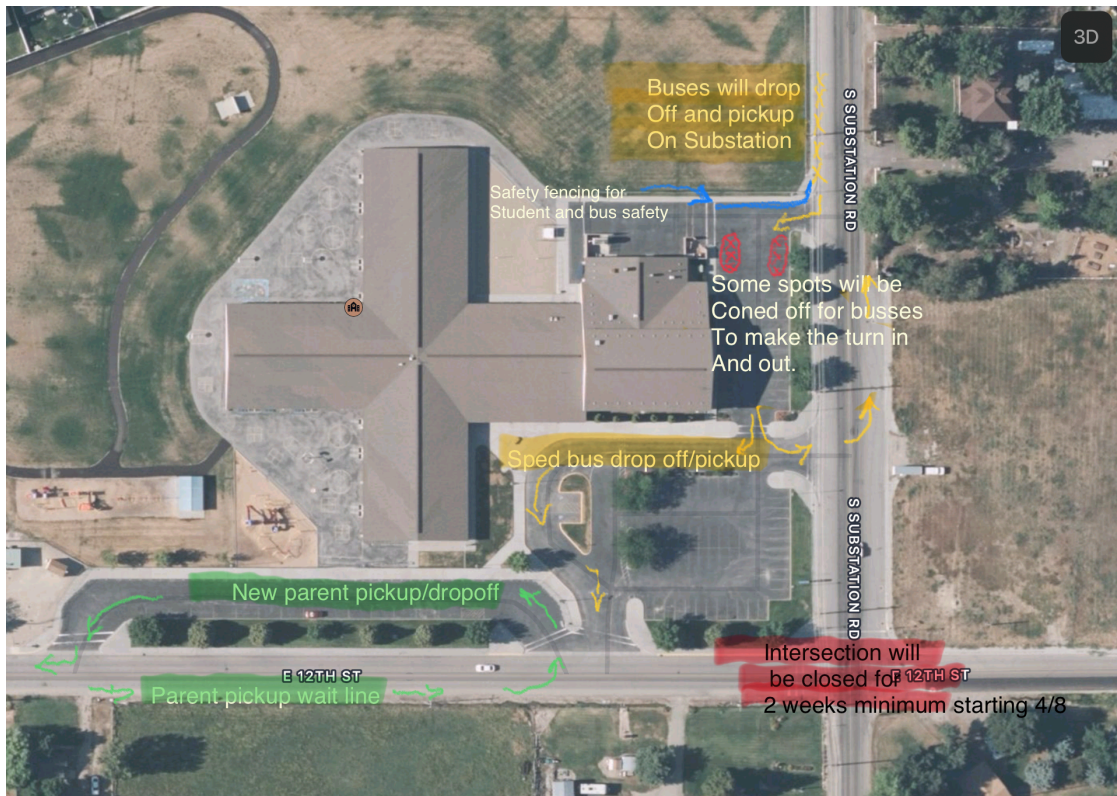


Carberry Elementary School
