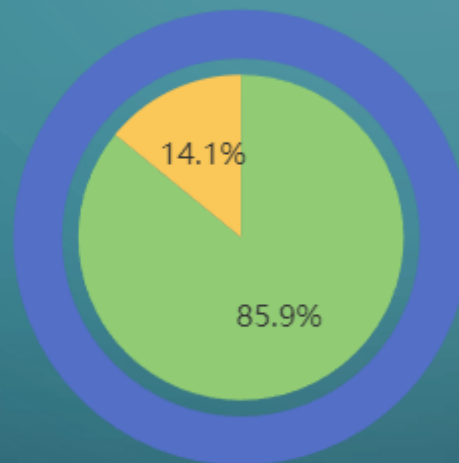

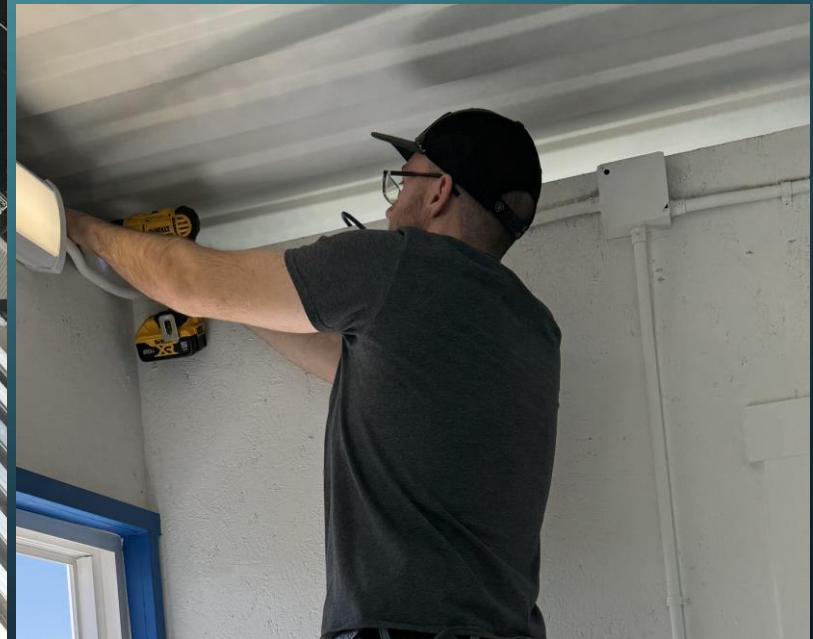

TIPS & TRICKS

- **Opening web links into a different browser tab doesn't mean you have to open the tab first.** There are a couple of ways to open up web links in a new tab without creating the tab first. Follow these steps to open web links in a new tab:
 - **Right-click:** When you right-click on a link, you will get a pop-up menu of options for the link. On Chrome, the first menu option will open the link in a new tab, while the second option will open it up in a new window.
 - **By holding down the control key and then clicking a link you will open that link up in the background in a new tab.** This is one of my most used keyboard shortcuts.
 - **Three-finger click or tap:** Chromebooks allow you to open a link in a new tab with a three finger click, or tap if tap to click is turned on.
