What is color guard?

Color guard is a team sport where we: dance, twirl and throw flags, rifles, and sabers. We perform routines during half time for football games, or basketball during our winter season. It also allows us to have a group chat to answer any questions, give updates etc. We post videos and written instruction to all of our routines, so the students are able to perform at home.
