

# 7TH-INNING UPRISING TOPPLES CROCKETT SOFTBALL; SOCCER CAVS ROLL 4-2

Foster was 2-for-3 to pace the Lady Cav offense, which was held to just four hits by relief pitcher Williamson and starter Rylee Key. The single by Maddox and a double by Lynden Cole were Crockett's only other safeties, although Hannah Carter reached twice on a walk and a hit-by-pitch, and also stole a base

Ray collected two hits and drove in a run to spark the Lady Choctaw offense before Williamson ended things with her walk-off blast.

The Lady Cavs play another big road district game Thursday night at Dyersburg at 6:30. Crockett's baseball team, which wasn't able to play Tuesday due to a wet field in Troy, will travel there today (Wednesday) for a 4:30 doubleheader against the host Obion County Rebels.

**SOCCER:** Finally getting an opportunity to play their home opener, the Crockett County Cavaliers scored a big 4-2 triumph over a talented Madison Academic team on the strength of a hat trick by Luke Carter.

Carter's three goals came on assists from Angel Garcia, Braulio Marquez, and Edgar Juarez. Marquez tallied the other Crockett goal for the winners, who are now 2-0 on the season for Coach Stan Jamscek.

Goaltenders Avery Hurst and Noah Mayfield both contributed key saves to the Crockett cause.

The Cavs are next scheduled to play on Friday, April 5 at Huntingdon in the Mustangs' tournament.

After being blanked for six innings on two hits by Crockett County's Anna Stallings, Dyer County cranked up a power surge in the final inning to generate three runs and post a 3-2 gut-punch victory over the Lady Cavaliers Tuesday night.

Winning pitcher Maddie Williamson followed one-out doubles by Lady Choctaw teammates Abbie Gibbons and Kierstyn Ray with a fly-ball home run over the center-field fence, erasing a Crockett lead that had held since the Lady Cavs scored in the fourth frame.

Crockett (now 9-4 and 2-1 in the district) had taken a 1-0 edge in the top of the fourth when Jayden Maddox led off with a single to center, took second on a groundout by Madison Solis, third on a groundout by Stallings, and then raced home when a Destiny Foster grounder to short was misplayed for an error.

The visiting Lady Cavs made it 2-0 in the sixth when Solis reached on an error. A fly-ball triple by Foster brought home pinch-runner Tink Willis. But the Dyer County long balls in the bottom of the seventh overcame the Crockett lead.
