Sick Children Reminder



As we enter into the fall and winter cold and flu season, please remember that if your student has a fever over 100, or other signs of contagious illness, they should not be in school.

This is also a good time to review your emergency pick up information, since often children who get sick at school need to be picked up by a friend or neighbor or a relative. We can only release students to people who are named on their emergency card, so please make sure that any and all people who may be called on to pick up your child are listed there, including older siblings, grandparents, and aunts and uncles.

To make changes, go into your ParentVue, click on Online Registration at the top of the first screen, and then click Ecard updates. Navigate through to the pages where you can add or edit your emergency contacts, and input as many as needed. Be sure to continue to the end and hit Save/Submit.

You may report absences on the absence phone line 248-726-4910 or in your ParentVue account.

WORK PERMITS

You can obtain a work permit in the main office. Most of our students will need the form for UNDER 16.

There is a separate form for 16 & 17 years old.

Complete Section I, have the employer complete Section II, then bring it back to VH to be completed. We will need a birth certificate of the student in order to complete the work permit. Work permits are completed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Monday-Friday.



Student Athletes Final Forms



Students who participate in athletics (tryouts or team) must have an account with final forms. Families create accounts, follow directions to complete forms, and add their student athlete to their account. Families must upload: physical (prior to a tryout) & pay to participate receipt. Athletic Directors check as often as they can to confirm the validity of uploaded documents.




