 - Each campus has developed and is implementing a Campus Improvement Plan (CIP), as required by TEC §11.253. These plans were reviewed and approved by the Board in the fall.
 - Plans include **performance objectives** based on data analysis and needs assessments – including data reported in annual TAPR reports.
 - Campus leaders **measure progress quarterly** toward the identified performance objectives.
